

COUNCIL MEETING: DECEMBER 9, 2025

The Town Council for the Town of Brantley met on Tuesday, December 9, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. at the Brantley Armory with the following members present: Mayor Walker, Linda Berry, Scott Beck, and Lorey Bogen. Dr. Charles Tompkins did not attend. Notice of meeting was posted at Town Hall, U.S. Post Office and Brantley Library. Others present: Diane Mears, Chief Averett, Bill Rayborn and several town residents.

Mayor Walker said prayer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was taken by Mayor Walker.

Motion was made by Councilman Bogen and seconded by Councilwoman Berry to accept November 13, 2025 Minutes as read. **Approved 3-0.**

Mayor Walker read to the council/audience the resignation letter from Councilman Darryl Elliott, effective as of December 9, 2025. Mayor stated that a new member must be appointed within the next sixty (60) days and if position is not filled at the end of sixty (60) days, then the Governor will appoint. Motion was made by Councilman Bogen and seconded by Councilman Beck to accept resignation and begin process of appointing a new member to the council. **Approved 3-0.**

Mayor Walker and Councilman Bogen will bring a suggestion/consideration of a new council member at the next meeting.

Mayor Walker stated that the water/sewage grant project is nearing a conclusion. Also, he stated that the water tank inspection/cleaning has been completed. Discussion followed regarding an electric box sinking at Camellia Village due to the tank drainage.


Mayor Walker stated that he met with Tim Daniels (to sell/lease property). Discussion followed regarding type of business Mr. Daniels wanted to establish and law regarding package store.

Motion was made by Councilman Bogen to give the Bailey property to Tim Daniels. No council member seconded the motion (motion failed). Councilman Beck stated that a full counsel was needed to decide about the sell or lease of Bailey property. Mayor tabled matter.


Mayor informed council that the Police Chief's salary (salaried or hourly) would be further discussed at the next police committee meeting.
