COUNCIL MEETING: FEBRUARY 10, 2026

The Town Council for the Town of Brantley met on Tuesday, February 10, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. at the Brantley Armory with the following members present: Mayor Walker, Linda Berry, Scott Beck, Charles Tompkins and Alfredia Wiley. Lorey Bogen was absent. Notice of meeting was posted at Town Hall, U.S. Post Office and Brantley Library. Others present were: Diane Mears, Bill Rayborn and several town residents.

Mayor Walker said prayer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was taken by Mayor Walker.

Motion was made by Councilman Beck and seconded by Councilwoman Berry to approve the January 13, 2026 Minutes. Approved 4-0.

Mayor Walker requested Judge Will Tate give the oath to newly appointed council member, Alfredia Wiley. Oath given.

MAYOR WALKER COMMENTS & ACTIONS:

- Mr. George Stringer had requested to speak – Prayer Walk will be held at Town Hall on February 28, 2026 beginning at 8:00 a.m.;
- Ms. Dot Baugh had requested to speak – Gave thanks to those responsible for paving the Davis cemetery; requested that the potholes on E. Emmett/Glenwood Rd. at the Brantley Housing be repaired; also mentioned that road stripes were needed on N. Sasser St.
- **Resolution 2026-2 “Town Employee Raises” was reviewed and motion was made by Councilman Tompkins and seconded by Councilwoman Berry to approve. Approved 4.0.** This resolution gave an hourly raise to: Police Officers (exclusion of Chief of Police), Water Department and Sanitation Department, reflected in the payroll for the month of March, 2026.
- **Resolution 2026-3 “Family Health Coverage (Paid by Town) was reviewed and motion was made by Councilwoman Berry and seconded by Councilman Beck to approve. Approved 4.0.** This resolution stated that no family coverage would be paid by the town for any employee as of June 1, 2026.
- **Motion was made by Councilman Beck and seconded by Councilman Tompkins to eliminate any and all meeting fees (Finance Committee, Police Committee, Representation at other affiliated meetings, etc.). Approved 4-0.**

- Bailey Property matter was tabled till presence of full council; Councilman Beck stated that a business plan should be presented to counsel by interested party or parties regarding the Bailey property.
- Councilman Tompkins stated that he was surprised at the number of children signed up, both boys and girls, of various ages for activities at the Recreation Park; he encouraged all those present to spread the word; also stating that Austin Brook was the Director of the Recreation Program should anyone be interested in participating.

Motion was made by Councilman Tompkins and seconded by Councilwoman Berry to adjourn. Approved (4-0).
