COUNCIL MEETING: AUGUST 12, 2025

The Town Council for the Town of Brantley met on Tuesday, August 12, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. at the Brantley Armory with the following members present: Mayor Sullivan, Steve Walker, Ashley Stewart, Darryl Elliott, Georgia Bush and Lorey Bogen. Notice of meeting was posted at Town Hall, U.S. Post Office and Brantley Library.

Others present were: Diane Mears, Chief Averett, Bill Rayborn and several Brantley residents.

Mayor said prayer. Roll call was taken by Mayor Sullivan.

Motion was made by Councilman Elliott and seconded by Councilman Stewart to accept July 8, 2025 Council Meeting Minutes. Approved (5-0).

Mayor's Comments:

- Bad Boys of Brantley Car Show at Pecan Grove on Saturday, August 16, 2025 (8:00 – 2:00) to benefit the Fire & Rescue Dept.
- Water/Sewage Project is in progress; Improvements after project is complete will include paving, sodding, sidewalks, etc.;
- Attended grant meeting with ADECA for \$400,000 grant to do School Dr. and Housing Area;
- Councilman Stewart asked about missing speed bumps on N. Sasser, School Dr. and Maple St.; Mayor will check status of same;
- Paving has not been completed and that will be decided by Wiregrass according to the weather; was told by Troy Hudson we had app. \$20,000 remaining funds to be used; will possibly pave Brantley Cemetery or front of Armory;
- Have talked with a few prospects for businesses; will notify council when it comes to fruition.
- Has been informed that Benny Carl Bush has sold the bank building; don't know all facts;
- Lines placed along streets – more paving projects on the way; we may can piggyback off that project;
- Met with ADECA for Recreational Grant; hope to have meeting with SCADC (Ashton Hutchinson) concerning recreational field and pond under state/federal ownership; can never be sold and only used for recreation;

- Mr. Benny Beard has donated the property located at W. Emmett (between Larry Ryals and Food Mart);
- Fuelworld will also be donated by Vance Bailey to the Town of Brantley;
- **Motion was made by Councilman Elliott and seconded by Councilman Stewart to accept Ordinance “Method for Sale and/or Lease of Municipal Property”; Approved (5-0);**
- Backhoe was repaired (\$516.00);
- Received a quote for a “backup” motor for the well - \$ 9,428.00;
- Met with Chief Averett and Asst. Chief Morgan regarding 2019 Tahoe; to sell or keep; will let Rick Bryan inspect before making decision;
- Rick Bryan is installing a new engine in Titus’ 2021 Tahoe.

Motion was made by Councilman Elliott and seconded by Councilman Stewart to Adjourn. Approved 5-0.
