COUNCIL MEETING: JUNE 25, 2026 **SPECIAL MEETING**

The Town Council for the Town of Brantley met on Thursday, June 25, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. at Town Hall with the following members present: Mayor Walker, Linda Berry, Scott Beck, Lorey Bogen and Alfredia Wiley. Dr. Tompkins was absent. Notice of meeting was posted at Town Hall, U.S. Post Office and Brantley Library. Others present were: Diane Mears, Bill Rayborn and two town residents.

Councilwoman Wiley said prayer. Roll call was taken by Mayor Walker. Four listed above were present.

MAYOR WALKER & COUNCIL COMMENTS & ACTIONS:

- Mayor Walker stated that Kevin Campbell has started a septic cleaning business and request approval to dump refuse at the Lagoon. Mayor will meet with Mr. Campbell regarding charge and how often used.
- Easement to South Central Alabama Mental Health due to lamp posts are positioned on town property; **Motion was made by Councilman Bogen and seconded by Councilwoman Wiley to authorize Mayor to sign Easement. Approved 4-0.**
- Mayor advised members that the Brantley Food Mart will be hooked up to the town's sewage system.
- Liquor License for "Brantley Liquor"; Councilwoman Berry explained that the Planning Committee had voted to make a special exception so that the Brantley Food Mart ("Brantley Liquor") could acquire a liquor license; Councilman Beck stated that he had concerns regarding the selling of vapes; Mayor stated that the sale of vapes is not part of the liquor license request; discussed was future guidelines for liquor requests; the clerk brought notice to council of the wording on the liquor license request – **"990 – Tobacco and Alternative Nicotine Products"**; stated that Sarah Davis (Alcoholic Beverage Control Board representative) stated that the Tobacco License was a separate license; Mayor stated that in the future liquor license will not be transferable; The topic of Sunday sales was discussed – Attorney stated that a cut-off time on Saturday needs to be established;
- **Motion was made by Councilman Beck and seconded by Councilwoman Berry regarding hours for selling liquor – Monday – Saturday (10:00 a.m. Monday morning until 10:00 p.m. Saturday night). Approved 4-0.**

- **Motion was made by Councilman Bogen and seconded by Councilwoman Wiley to approve Brantley Liquor to have a Liquor License – 011 – Lounge Retail Liquor – Class II (Package). Approved 4-0.**
- Mayor Walker reminded members of change in next council meeting to Thursday, July 16, 2026. This is a one-time change.
- **Motion was made by Councilman Bogen and seconded by Councilwoman Berry to adjourn. Approved 4-0.**
