VAN DRIVER

Boys & Girls Club of Southern Maine, Portland/South Portland location: seeking part-time van drivers to transport members from school to club locations, on field trips and to/from home. With safety of youth and teens as top priority, van drivers will provide daily transportation to meet program needs.

Responsibilities:

- Drive a 12-passenger van and transport youth and teens around the Portland area.
- Perform daily pre and post route safety inspections on assigned vehicle. Report any issue to Unit Director.
- Keep the vehicle free from damage, in acceptable condition, and maintain a consistently clean interior.
- Keep written records of trips, mileage, and records of passenger counts.
- Documents incidents and accidents with written reports when necessary.
- Follow all the rules of the road.

Qualifications/Skills:

- Hold a valid driver's license and possess an excellent driving record.
- Demonstrate excellent attendance and reliability.
- Must be at least 21 years old with a high school diploma, GED or equivalent.
- Ability to work afterschool and evening hours
- Ability to perform considerable reaching, stooping, and bending as it pertains to the responsibilities above (routine vehicle inspections, custodial upkeep of the van, etc.).
- Hearing and vision abilities within normal range (corrected) to drive safely and to observe and communicate with members.

- Team oriented work environment
- Maine Earned Paid Leave – up to 40 hours PTO per year based on hours worked.
