ORGANIZATION

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Southern Maine Alumni Association is an incorporated organization affiliated with Boys & Girls Clubs of Southern Maine. The Alumni Association was founded in 1959 by a group of former members who wanted to give back to an organization that played such an important role in their lives.

MISSION

The purpose of the Alumni Association is to support the work of the local Clubs and to promote the Boys & Girls Club movement. The Alumni Association embraces the mission of the Clubs, to inspire and enable all young people, especially those who need us most, to realize their full potential as productive, caring and responsible citizens.

MEETINGS

Business meetings are generally held bi-monthly on the third Wednesday. A brief social begins at 6:00 PM and a spaghetti supper is served at 6:30 PM, followed by the business meeting at 7:00 PM. The Officers and Board of Directors meet on the alternating third Wednesday, beginning each September.
