Opening Scripture

Hebrews 11:17-29

Verses: 17

By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten *son*,

Verse: 18-19

of whom it was said, “In Isaac your seed shall be called,” ¹⁹ concluding that God *was* able to raise *him* up, even from the dead, from which he also received him in a figurative sense.

Verse:20-21

By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come. By faith Jacob, when he was dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph, and worshipped, leaning on the top staff.

Verse:23

By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden three months by his parents, because they saw *he was* a beautiful child; and they were not afraid of the king's command.

Verse:24-25

By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, ²⁵ choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin,

Verse:26-27

Esteeming the approach of Christ greater riches than the treasures he looked to the reward. By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who was invisible.

Verse:28-29

By faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood, lest he who destroyed the first born should touch them. By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land, whereas the Egyptians, attempting to do so were drowned.

The Power of Faith

Trusted faith doesn't just survive the present it shapes the future.

1. Trusted Faith Requires:

- ✓ Obedience with explanation
- ✓ Moving without visible outcomes
- ✓ Trusting God's ability over human logic

2. Purpose Over Comfort

- ✓ Willing to lose status
- ✓ Willing to leave comfort
- ✓ Willing to endure difficulty for calling

3. Takes Action

- ✓ Steps forward without guarantees
- ✓ Move while fear is present
- ✓ Acts immediately on Gods word
