Morning Glory

“Increase”

Increase

Increase is the act or process of becoming greater in size, quantity, value, strength, or influence (To advance beyond your current state).

Biblical Increase

Refers to expansion of what God has entrusted to a person, whether that is resources, influence, fruitfulness, or favor.

Increase Language

- ✓ Multiplication
- ✓ Fruitfulness
- ✓ Abundance
- ✓ Prosperity
- ✓ Growth

Increase is Not:

Adding $1+1=2$

Increase is:

Multiplying $1 \times 2 = 2$
(Increase Begins)

Multiplication

Multiplication does not become visible until you move beyond two; because multiplication is designed to produce exponential growth rather than simple duplication.

The Difference:

✓ Addition grows linearly

$$2+2+2+2+2=10$$

✓ Multiplication grows

exponentially $2 \times 2 \times 2 \times 2 = 16$

God's System:

Is not built on addition, it's
built on multiplication.

The Difference

- ✓ Addition keeps you surviving.
- ✓ Multiplication allows you to thrive!

Multiplying Scriptures:

- ✓ Be fruitful and multiply. Genesis 1:28
- ✓ Other seed fell on good ground and yielded a crop that sprang up, increased and produced: some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some hundred.

Key Principles:

Obey the laws!

1. Sowing and Reaping

Your harvest corresponds to
the measure of your seed.

Verse:6

“But this *I say*: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.

2. Attitude of Giving

God examines the heart
behind the seed, not just the
seed itself.

Verse:7

So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

3. The Provision Promise

God ensures that those who give will have sufficiency and abundance.

Verse:8

And God *is* able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all *things*, may have an abundance for every good work.

4. The Practice of Generosity

Generosity reflects the heart
and righteous living.

Verse:9

As it is written ”He has dispersed abroad, He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever.”

5. Principle of Multiplication

1. Supplies seed
2. Multiplies the seed
3. Increases the harvest

Verse: 10

Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness.

Closing Thought:

God did not place seed in our hands so we could protect it, He placed seed in our hands so we could plant it and watch Him multiply it!

Don't just manage it multiply it!
