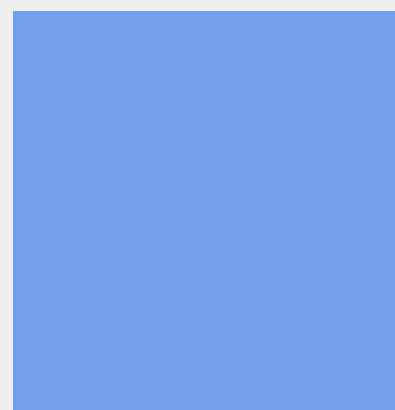

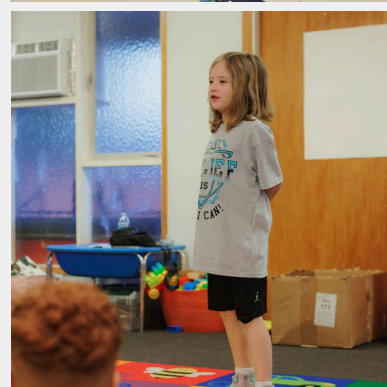
Student Impact

At Rise Up Academy, we believe every child can learn. Starting from age two, our students build strong foundations in literacy, numeracy, and social-emotional skills. Our rigorous program ensures they not only meet but exceed public school benchmarks, preparing them for success in school and life..

Community Impact

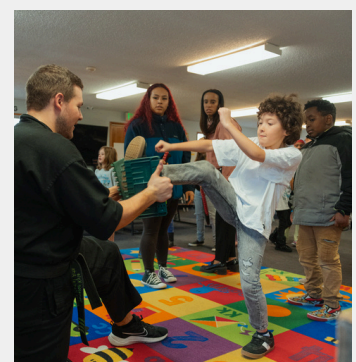
At Rise Up Academy, we serve as a community hub for families in Everett and Mukilteo. Our after-school program provides a safe, supportive space for elementary students to learn, complete homework, and unwind in a structured environment.

In just a little over a month, one of our 1st graders went from struggling to read independently to soaring — jumping from a 741 to a 766 on his reading score! That's a 25-point growth, showing nearly a 3.4% improvement in a very short time — but even more importantly, he's now reading on his own with confidence and joy thanks to Accelerated Reader.



We're proud to share that **83%** of our students have improved their reading comprehension, thanks to the dedication of our staff and the power of Accelerated Reader.

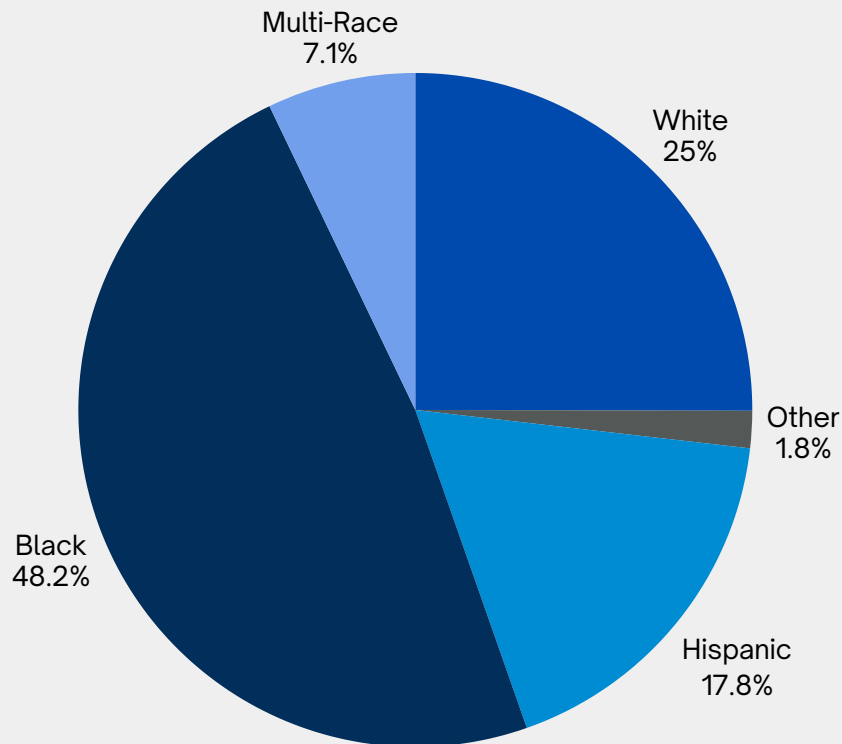
Thanks to our sports grant, we offered a free martial arts class to all students and the community — teaching self-defense, building confidence, and strengthening public speaking skills!

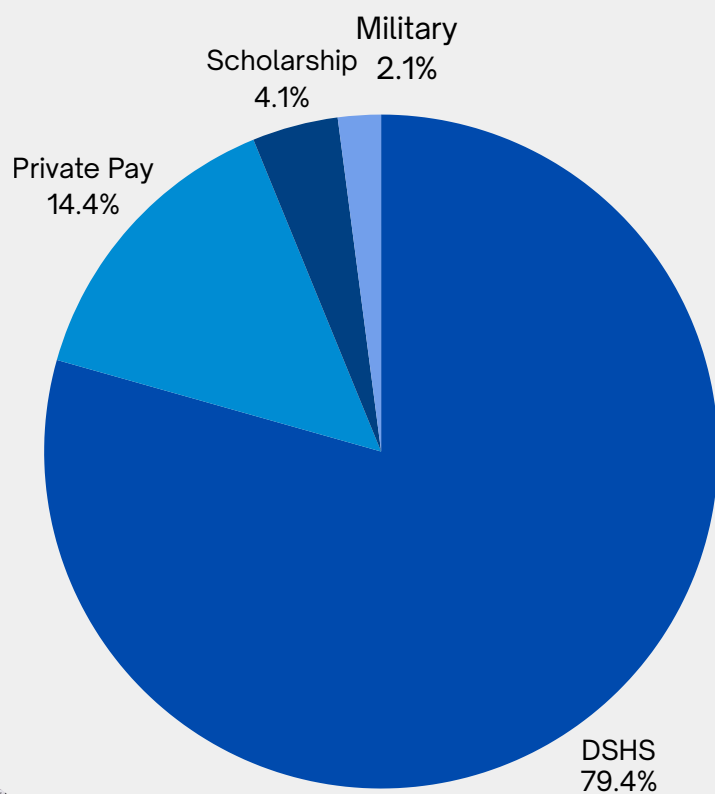

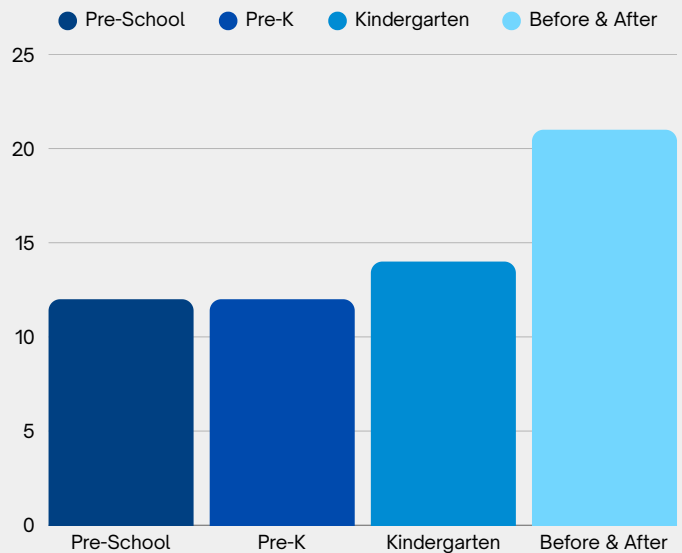

Our classrooms maintain a **6:1 student-to-teacher ratio**, allowing for more individualized care, guidance, and support. This small group environment helps us better understand each child's unique needs and foster stronger relationships between students and teachers.

Educational Excellence

At Rise Up Academy in Everett, Washington, we provide a strong academic foundation through the McGraw Hill Reading and Math Mastery curriculum. With focused instruction from 9:00 to 11:00 a.m., students consistently excel—many surpassing grade-level expectations. Some kindergarten graduates even advance directly into second or third grade. After academics, students enjoy enriching activities like art, STEAM, and play, supporting well-rounded growth. We promote students based on **achievement and development**, not just age, helping every child reach their full potential.



At Rise Up Academy, we are committed to building strong academic foundations. Our structured morning sessions ensure focused learning, allowing students to develop critical literacy and math skills that often exceed grade-level expectations. In addition to core academics, we introduce students to piano and music theory, enriching their cognitive development, memory, and problem-solving abilities. This well-rounded approach not only prepares our students for success in the classroom but also equips them with the skills and confidence to thrive in their future learning journeys.

At Rise Up Academy, our school-age program uses the Accelerated Reader (AR) program and STAR assessments to foster a love for reading and improve literacy skills. AR helps students enhance their reading comprehension, fluency, and overall academic performance. Students took their first STAR test in December and retested in February, with over half demonstrating measurable growth. Remarkably, two students who started the year unable to read are now reading independently. Through consistent support, goal-setting, and celebrating progress, we are building confident readers with a lifelong passion for learning.



Student Achievements

At Rise Up Academy, we set high expectations—and our students rise to meet them. From preschool through kindergarten, our children are excelling academically and developing the foundational skills they need for lifelong success.

In our preschool classrooms, students are mastering letter recognition, phonics, and number identification up to 10 and beyond. By pre-K, they are sounding out new words, beginning to read, and learning simple addition—including double-digit equations. By the time they reach kindergarten, students are confidently reading books independently, solving double- and triple-digit addition and subtraction problems, counting money, and tackling word problems.

Our goal is simple: equip every child with the tools to thrive—now and in the future.

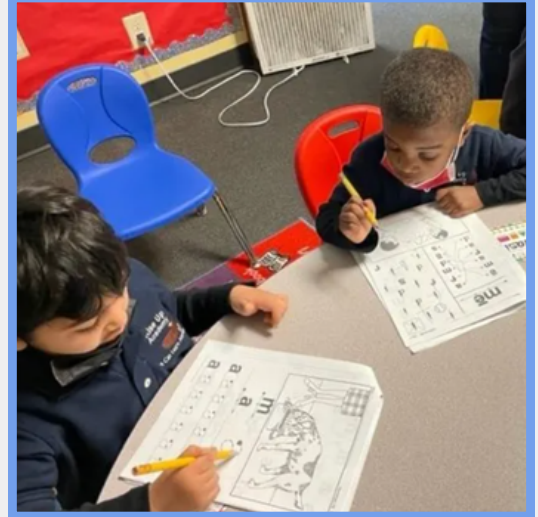

Rise Up Academy Classrooms

PRESCHOOL

Rise Up Academy's Preschool focuses on early literacy and foundational math skills. Students engage in daily activities that enhance their understanding of the alphabet, letter sounds, and basic math concepts. By the end of Preschool, children can recognize numbers 1-30, perform simple addition and subtraction, and write their names. The curriculum also introduces shapes and colors, laying the groundwork for future learning.

Our innovative Reading and Math curriculum has been instrumental in closing achievement gaps over the past 23 years. With a low student-to-teacher ratio, each child receives personalized attention, ensuring a strong start in their educational journey.



PRE-K



Rise Up Academy's Pre-Kindergarten program builds upon the strong foundation established in our Preschool, preparing students for advanced Kindergarten-level phonics and math. Students master letter names and sounds, blend sounds to read simple words and stories, and answer comprehension questions. In math, they count to 100 by ones and tens from any given number, solve addition and subtraction word problems, and compose and decompose numbers 11 to 19 into tens and ones (e.g., $18 = 10 + 8$).

Our curriculum introduces students to STEAM education—Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math—fostering curiosity and critical thinking. We emphasize social and emotional development, teaching resilience, mindfulness, and adaptability to prepare students for lifelong learning.

With a low student-to-teacher ratio, our dedicated educators provide personalized support, ensuring each child thrives academically and personally.

Rise Up Academy's Kindergarten offers an accelerated yet supportive curriculum, ensuring students remain motivated and confident. With a low student-to-teacher ratio, each child receives personalized attention, fostering academic excellence.

Over the past 23 years, our innovative Reading and Math curriculum has effectively closed achievement gaps. By the end of Kindergarten, students read at a first-grade level, decode multisyllabic words, and comprehend story structures, including beginning, middle, and end. In Math, they perform double-digit addition and subtraction, count by ones and tens up to 120, and understand numerical relationships up to three digits.

Beyond academics, students engage in extracurricular activities such as music, health and fitness, typing, and chess club, promoting well-rounded development.

KINDERGARTEN



Rise Up Academy Programs

Before and After School Program

Rise Up Academy's Before and After School Program supports academic success throughout the year and is available to students up to 12 years old.

During the school year, the program focuses on homework assistance, mentoring and tutoring. During summer break, Rise Up offers a number of sports camps to keep students active when they're not in the classroom.



During the school year, our Before and After School Program's main focus is on academic support, providing students with the tutoring and individual attention they need to be successful. Weekly STEM and Chess Club activities also support the students' development of reasoning and problem-solving skills.

Rise Up Academy provides transportation to and from a number of schools in the Mukilteo and Everett School Districts.

Over summer break, Rise Up maintains a focus on reading and math to ensure students are prepared for the following school year. Weekly online testing allows teachers to track progress and keep students on pace. Students are incentivized with individual and class prizes for math and reading achievements throughout the summer.

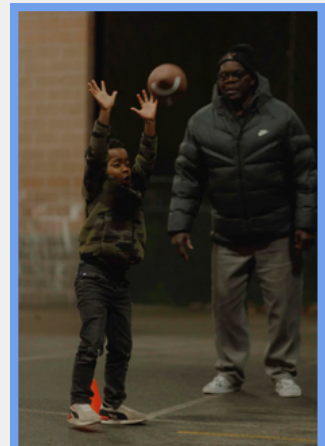
Rise Up Academy also offers a number of summer sports camps to keep our children active including golf, basketball, tennis and running club.

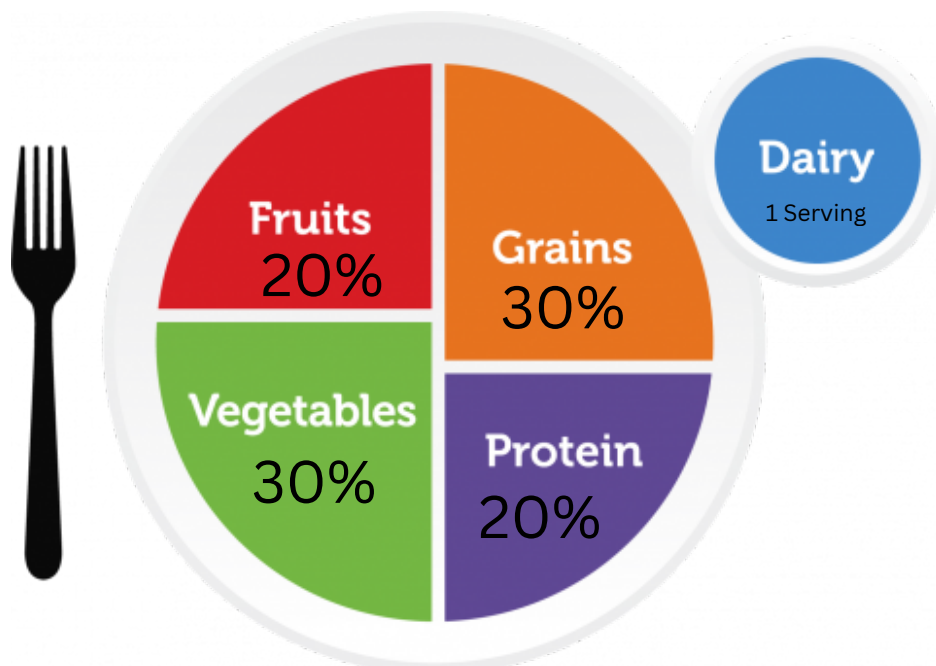

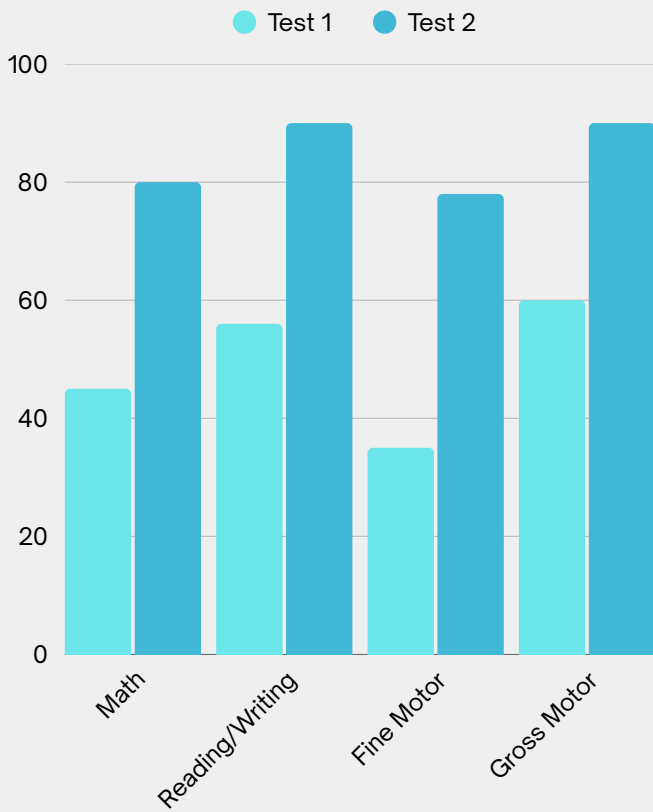

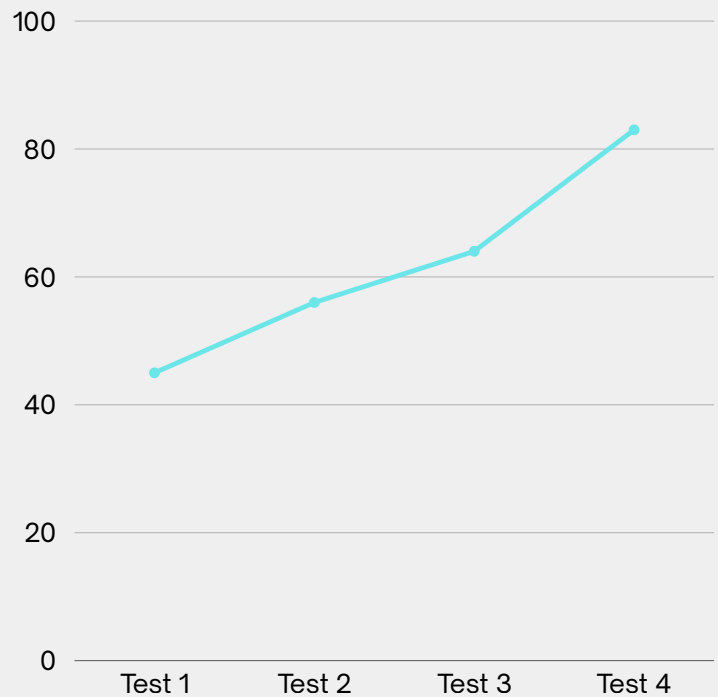
Student Performance Analysis

Business Consulting Program

Through the University of Washington's Business Consulting Program, students partnered with Rise Up Academy on a "Quantifying Impact" project to strengthen how we measure and communicate outcomes.

The consulting team:

- Developed the framework for this annual Impact Report.
- Helped implement **Airtable** to track student progress, assessments, organizational metrics, and staff evaluations.
- Conducted research and data analysis to support impact measurement, fundraising, and future growth.

Their work continues to support data-driven decision-making across the organization.

Student Internships & Experiential Learning

RUA has hosted numerous interns from the University of Washington and UW Bothell studying in education, business, nonprofit management, marketing, and communications fields. These experiences provide valuable hands-on learning opportunities while strengthening services for the children and families we serve.

AMA Agency

Rise Up Academy has partnered with multiple student consulting teams through the UW AMA Agency. Their recommendations strengthened our marketing, communications, fundraising, and outreach efforts, contributing to a 208% increase in email open rates and improved digital engagement.

UW Athletics Community Partnership

Through the UW Athletics Non-Profit Organization Ticket Program, Rise Up Academy students, families, and staff have had the opportunity to attend a wide variety of Husky athletic events, including football, basketball, baseball, softball, and other UW sporting events. Future Plans

The New Rise Up Academy

Estimated Cost of New School
Construction: \$10,332,000



Rise Up Academy is excited to announce a transformative initiative to redevelop our campus in South Everett, highlighted by a new 10,000 square-foot school and early learning center. This will replace our nearly 60-year-old building, which no longer meets the needs of our growing community.

The new facility will allow us to double the number of students we serve, from 65 to 130, while maintaining our commitment to low student-teacher ratios and personalized attention.

Key features of the new facility include:

- **Twice the space of the current building**
- **Double the classrooms, from three to six**
- **A Performing Arts Space, the Krist Novoselic Performing Arts and Theatre Classroom, also supporting STEAM learning**
- **An expanded library and technology hub, featuring the Anne Brenner Reading Room and Library**
- **Classrooms with cutting-edge technology**
- **A new cafeteria and kitchen**

We're adding a rooftop playground and refurbishing the sport court, which is over 20 years old. The facility will be designed to meet green building standards with potential for LEED certification, promoting environmental responsibility among students.

As RUA begins preparations for the campaign, we are conducting a fundraising feasibility study to assess the level of anticipated philanthropic support and develop the most effective strategy to secure donor-advised funds. The study will involve confidential interviews with members of the RUA community and the broader public. The results will guide the school's decision-making process.

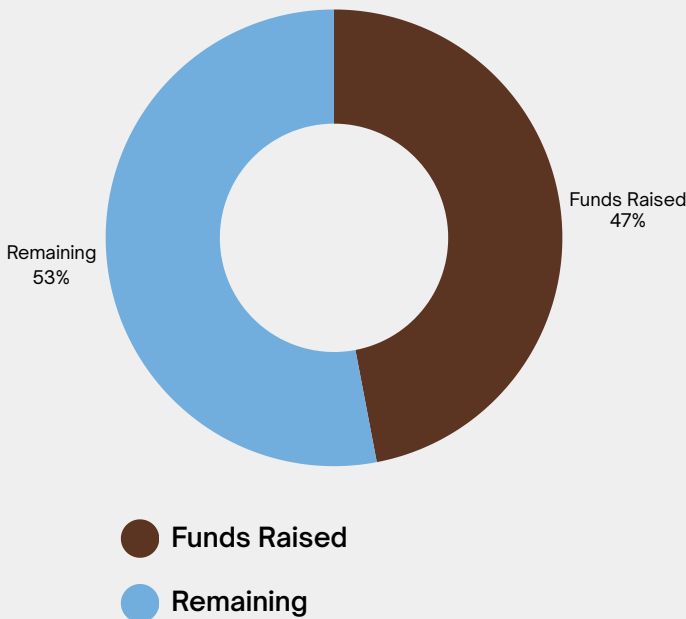
This project will provide Rise Up Academy with a modern, sustainable space to continue empowering students and families for years to come.
