Quantities have been adjusted based on the needs of all classrooms and programs to provide a clear and transparent view of what is required. Cubbies/Lockers	1 per child	Personal item storage
First Aid Kits	1 per classroom	Stocked and licensed-compliant
Emergency Contact Binders	1 per classroom	Allergy alerts, emergency contacts

Audio Players/Speakers	1 per classroom	For songs, stories, and guided movement



8. General & Daily Supplies

Backpacks or Tote Bags	1 per child	For transport of daily belongings
Extra Clothing Sets	2 per child (on site)	Labeled and stored in cubbies
Nap Mats/Sleeping Bags	1 per child (ages 2–5)	With washable covers
Tissues & Paper Towels	Monthly restock	For hygiene, spills, and cleanup
Thermal Lamination Sheets	4 packs per classroom	3mil & 5mil with any finish
Hand Sanitizer Stations	2 per classroom	Child-safe formula preferred
Clipboards & Laminated Charts	4 per classroom	Used for attendance, routines, or safety logs

9. Sensory & Enrichment Supplies

Item	Estimated Quantity	Notes
Shaving Cream	2 cans per classroom	Sensory art and letter tracing
Sensory Bins	2–3 per classroom	Filled with rice, beans, pasta, etc.
Bubble Wands	15 per classroom	Outdoor play, fun with cause/effect
Kinetic Sand	9 Bulk packs	For hands-on sculpting and fine motor skills
