**Whithorn Pilgrimage:** The national annual pilgrimage to Whithorn will take place this year on Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> August, with mass on the beach celebrated at 4pm by Bishop Frank, and mass in the church at 4.45pm.

**Deanery Pastoral Council:** Bishop Frank has asked that we form Deanery Pastoral Councils throughout the Diocese. The first initial meeting for the deanery in North Ayrshire has been arranged for 7pm in St Peter's Ardrossan on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> September. This meeting will look at how the DPC and future meetings will be organised. We are looking for one or two people from each of our three parishes to represent the Garnock Valley at this meeting. If you are interested, please let me know.

**Jubilee Event:** the parishes of North Ayrshire are invited to join with people from across the Diocese for on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> September as "Pilgrims of Hope". There will be a walk, starting at 2.30pm, from St John's, Stevenston to St Peter's, Ardrossan, followed by a picnic on the grass directly in front of St Peter's. Those not wanting to walk the whole distance can chose to walk from St Mary's Saltcoats, starting about 3.15pm, or even just meet for the picnic at St Peter's. There will also be a short service in the church for those who wish to attend, starting about 5pm. Should the weather prove too poor to picnic outside we will 'picnic' in St Peter's Hall instead. All very welcome, but please bring your own picnic.
