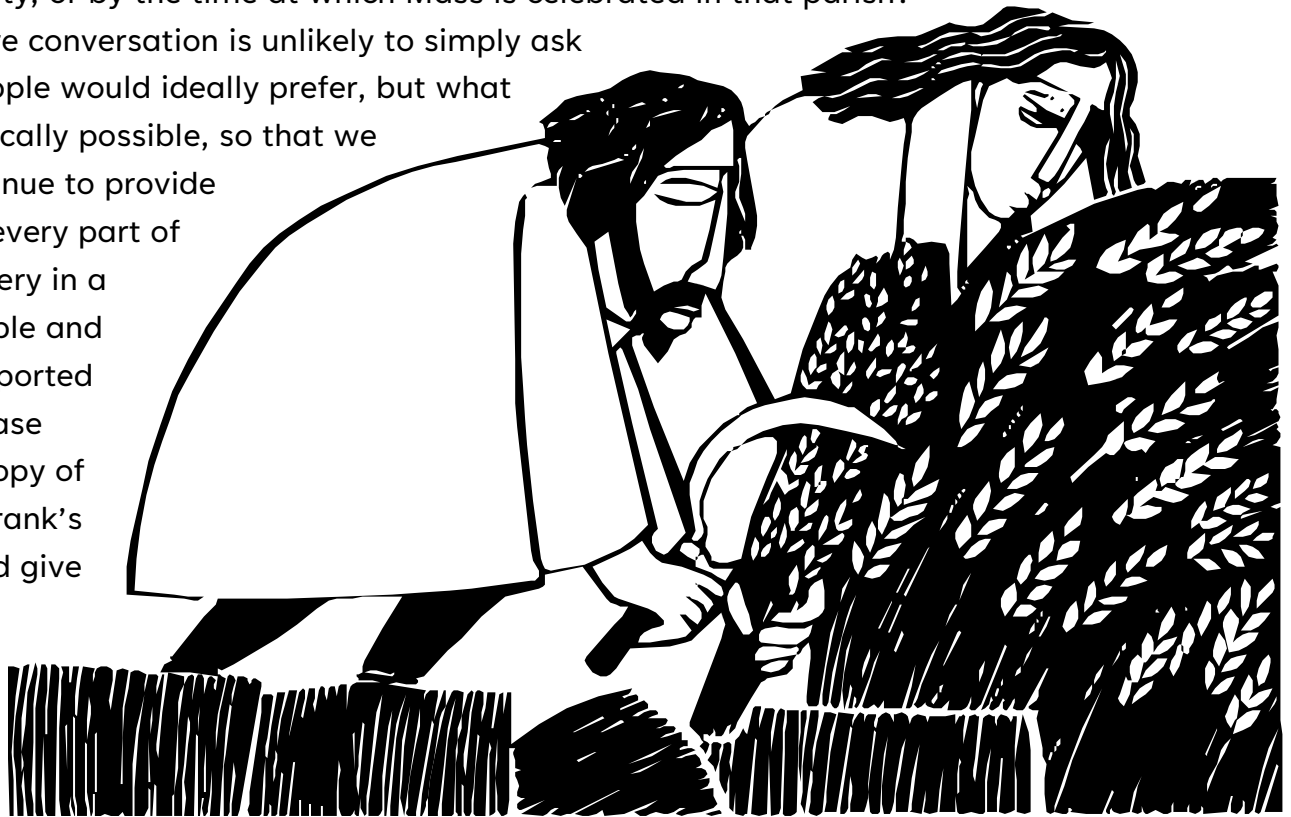

Mass Times & Bishop Frank's Pastoral Letter: The Bishop has written a pastoral letter to everyone in the Diocese asking us all to think about where and when Mass is celebrated in our Diocese and our deanery, which not only includes the parishes of the Garnock Valley, but stretches as far south as Irvine and as far north as Largs, and includes Millport. Before we engage in that conversation with others, I invite you to give a little thought to your weekend routine, where Sunday mass fits in that, and any sense of parish. For example, do you usually join Mass in the same parish, or does it vary, depending on what else is happening that weekend? Is your choice determined more by a sense of belonging to a particular parish community, or by the time at which Mass is celebrated in that parish?

Any future conversation is unlikely to simply ask what people would ideally prefer, but what is realistically possible, so that we can continue to provide Mass in every part of the deanery in a sustainable and well-supported way. Please Take a copy of Bishop Frank's letter and give it a little thought for now.
