Therapeutic Childcare Services

Our Bachelor degreed team members strengthen each child through customized therapy, love, support, and nutritious food.



Children received services averaging 10 months of treatment per family.

19,985 Healthy meals served to children.

14,128 Hours of Therapeutic Childcare and Clinical Treatment were provided.

Home Visitation

Licensed Family Support Counselors visit each family weekly to identify goals, improve family interactions, develop positive parenting skills and to improve the family's overall mental health.



Number of parents or caregivers served

1.521 Home Visits were completed.

Families reported that they had increased knowledge and gained the skills to be able to help their child.

98% Families reported that they are satisfied with the services offered by A Child's Haven.

Families with a need identified at enrollment received a out-of-agency referral.

Parent Education Support

Our evidenced based parenting classes reinforce the one-on-one home visit training and provide the tools they need to raise healthy and successful children.



Hours of Parent Education Class was administered.

Families completed the 12week parenting group course

Caregivers reported that they deal more effectively with daily problems or challenges after program services.




