DIVERSE MARINE STORM CLASS CTV

Offshore Wind Crew Transfer Vessel



The Diverse Marine Storm Class CTV has been developed using 20 years of experience of such craft in combination with designer, builder, multiple CTV operators, wind farm developers and prime contractors to meet construction and O&M project requirements.

Extensive CFD has been carried out develop the hull form that incorporates an ultra-fine entry for excellent head sea performance and tower access but with high reserves of buoyancy above the main chine to provide for equally good following and stern quarter sea keeping performance.

The hull form has been optimised to maximise efficiency without compromising performance ensuring the form is well suited to future alternative fuel and mixed fuel installations. The high bow and low propulsion line ensure impressive access limits whilst a resilient deckhouse provides a safe and quiet environment for crew and technicians during transit and transfer.

Available as Quad IPS, Quad Hybrid IPS, Twin IPS Professional Hybrid, Twin CPP, Twin CPP Hybrid and in the future alternative fuels leading to full electric to cater for different end user requirements and budgets.





During the CFD process, the design team assessed many options to reduce hull resistance and as a result the hull form dismisses a conventional chine construction in favouror a rounded bilge type design. In CFD this resulted in all% reduction in resistance at transition speed, commonly referred to as 'hump speed' and a 7% reduction in resistanceat operational speed. Reduction in resistance results in areduction of fuel burn and CO2 emissions speed for speed.



The Storm Class is configured with a balanced compromise of internal outfit and large forward cargo deck. A large resiliently mountedsuperstructure accommodates a step free forward access door to the bow of the vessel. A spacious passenger saloon with tiered seating, large galley, and mess area. The saloon has large, double-glazed windows to maximise passenger comfort and reduce motion sickness and is fitted with motion sensors connected to the vessels Al based motion and performance monitoring system.



The main deck is 'step free' for the technicians with a large forward deck capable of accommodating 10ft and 20ft containers, main deck crane, pressure washer system and bow transfer area with a cupped Buoyant Works bow fender system to maximise transfer capability. The fuel transfer System has a reel below the main deck to maximise reliability.
