EMERGENCY TIMES

The recent fire emergencies put so many at risk for the loss of property, land, animals, and possessions. Our local community remains safe but "Kudos" to all who helped! As a reminder, we just want to let our existing and new residents know how we respond to situations like those that recently occurred at the Oregon Fire in Spokane/Pend Oreille Counties of Washington.

The Community Center has a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Bonner County Emergency Management department that in the event of a public health emergency or natural disaster, the Center will be notified by Bonner County to work together to both secure and provide shelter for displaced citizens and emergency personnel affected such an emergency. This agreement is implemented when the County makes a declaration of a disaster, or an emergency exists. The Community Center continues to add supplies, such as, cots, provisions, food, and a sufficient generator to successfully handle these situations where numbers of persons are to be housed.
