Important Election Announcement

Sometimes, organizations and their Boards go through a period of fluctuation due to issues such as, retirement, resignation, relocation, and/or realignment of goals. When this happens, the flexibility of the Membership and its Officers are put to the test. Last November, BASIC/Blanchard Community Center encountered such circumstances and the Membership elected 5 out of 7 vacancies to be filled. Thank you, Membership, for your flexibility and Thank you, Board Members, for accepting the challenge. Now, with a fully functioning Board, the following will explain how we are transitioning those term positions and circumstances according to the By-Laws.

The **CHANGED** Annual Meeting of BASIC/Blanchard Community Center will be held on **Tuesday, November 15, 2022** with the primary purpose being to Elect and Install members of the Board. (State Elections are on Nov. 8) According to the By-Laws, on even numbered years in November, the President, Secretary, and Board Member-At-Large #1 are elected for two (2) years. In November of odd numbered years, the Vice-President, Treasurer, and Board Members-at-Large #2 & #3 are also elected for a two (2) year term.

Therefore, on November 15, 2022 elections will be held for the President, the Secretary, and Board Member-at-large #1 will, once again, be on the ballot. A Nominating Committee is being formed to develop Position Descriptions so that anyone who accepts a nomination is fully informed of the duties of the position. Furthermore, it's permissible to nominate yourself as well as additional other talent; write-in candidates are also permissible. The Board is committed to mentoring new participants.
