BACK TO "BASIC"s 2022 Election of 3 Board Members

Last November, BASIC/Blanchard Community Center had encountered a period of Board fluctuation due to various issues. Consequently, the Membership needed to elect 5 out of 7 Board vacancies. According to the By-Laws, on uneven numbered years, like 2021, four positions are elected: Vice President, Treasurer, and 2 Directors-at-large. Simultaneously, the President and Board Member-At-Large #1 were elected to serve an interim timeframe until the 2022 elections were held.

If you would like to be a candidate or if you know someone who would like to be a candidate, nominations for write-in candidates can be made from the floor on the night of the elections. Position descriptions/expectations will be available to review on Nov. 15.

Candidates, who have read the position description/expectations, and have accepted the current nomination for the 2022 Election are:

- **President Ballot: Ruthanna Cadd** who was elected President last November, has consented to run again for another term. She has spent the last year totally immersed in the Community Center operations. Ruthanna retired from State Compensation Insurance Fund and primarily worked in Finance and Accounting. Her volunteer and non-profit experience came from her years with the Boy Scouts of America. We have an energetic and dedicated leader!
- <u>Secretary Ballot: Holly Stewart:</u> Holly is currently the chairperson for facility rentals, the website, and artistic event flyers. Holly has been vetted on the work of the Secretary position and accepts the nomination. Her background includes: 32+ years of graphic design for publications, brochures, newsletters, business cards, flyers, advertisements and other forms of printed and electronic media. She also provided administrative services such as, conference planning and registration, website hosting and updates, coordinating workshops and registration, and attending board meetings.
- **<u>Director-at-Large Ballot:</u>** The 2 Nominees for one position are:
 - Deborrah Purcifull: Elected last November to serve this interim role, Deb has consented to run again for this position. She also has been volunteering in a number of the Center's events. Her background includes: dedication to the work, fundraising, and the leadership of Habitat for Humanity. She was also President of the Puyallup Valley Gem & Mineral Club who voted her "Woman of the Year".
 - Michael Stewart: Mike has been volunteering at the center with the country breakfasts, gun shows, and taking care of some general building maintenance. His background includes: 20 years in the Air Force as a Military Jet Aircraft Mechanic, retirement from Boeing Commercial Aircraft as an Aircraft Maintenance Technician & Inspection, and he also possesses a certificate in welding.

No other candidates were presented at the time of this Newsletter. If you cannot attend the election, Proxy voting is permitted. A Proxy appointment form is attached to this Newsletter. Please have your Assignee present it on Nov. 15 before voting begins.
