To all High School parents and guardians:

As your child returns to High School, the Food Service Department of Tunkhannock Area School District would like to take this opportunity to welcome everyone back and inform you of a change within the cafeteria of the high school.

Your child can purchase a breakfast for \$0.00, Lunch for \$3.55, or milk for \$0.60.

The High School cafeteria extend charging privileges of meals to all students. However, please be aware of the following charging Policy:

- 1) When a student has charges on their account, a written communication will be sent to the parents/guardians thru e-mail or the US Mail.
- 2) Unresolved accounts will be followed up with a telephone call to the parents/guardians.
- 3) Excessive negative accounts will be referred to the Superintendent who will schedule a meeting with the parents/guardians.

Students will be served all meals in the cafeteria. Breakfast will consist of hot and cold options. Breakfast will be available each morning for pick up in the cafeteria. Lunches will also be served in the cafeteria. All student meals received will be charged to the student's account. The Menus are posted on the Food Service Web Site by Metz Food Service. Free and Reduced-price lunches are available to those who qualify. If you believe that your household qualifies, please complete an application at www.paschoolmeals.com. If your student currently receives free or reduced meal benefits, these benefits will remain in effect for the first thirty (30) school days of the 2026-2027 school year. Please be sure to submit a new 2026-2027 Free and Reduced Meal Application before October 7, 2026 to avoid a lapse in benefits. Every student's meal benefit information remains confidential and is protected by overt identification.

You can review your child's transaction history or check their balance by creating an account at no charge at www.mymealtime.com. Parents will need their student's ID number to set up an account.
