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**Lackawanna College Dual Enrollment 2025-26**  
January 2026

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

The Tunkhannock Area School District is pleased to offer **dual enrollment through Lackawanna College**. Our dual enrollment program allows qualified students to earn college credits at a dramatically reduced rate while completing their high school requirements. This is a voluntary program.

Students may take identified courses within our building and with our TAHS teachers to earn college credits through Lackawanna College. These college credits may be transferable to the college or university of student’s choice upon graduation. To determine credit transferability, we encourage students and parents to contact any college to which the student will be applying. We suggest that students and parents ask potential colleges if they accept credits from Lackawanna College *and* if they accept these credits within desired majors.

Attached is a list of courses that may be dual enrolled through Lackawanna College as well as registration information. Registration and payment are done online directly between the student and Lackawanna College and must be **completed by March 17, 2026**, for second semester courses taken at TAHS. The cost is **\$100 a credit** and students **must earn 73% or better** in the TAHS course to be awarded college credit.
