## Luzerne County Community College (LCCC) Dual Enrollment 2025-26 February 2026

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

The Tunkhannock Area School District is pleased to offer **dual enrollment through Luzerne County Community College for Speech and Debate (LCCC's SPE 125)**. The dual enrollment agreement with LCCC allows students to earn college credits at a dramatically reduced rate (\$300 or less) while completing their high school requirements. This is a voluntary program.

A student entering into this agreement must earn a **78% or better** in the TAHS Speech & Debate course to earn 3 credits for SPE 125. These college credits *may* be transferable to the college or university of the student's choice upon graduation. To determine credit transferability, we encourage students and parents to contact any college to which the student will be applying. We suggest that students and parents ask potential colleges if they accept credits from LCCC *and* if they accept these credits (SPE 125) within desired majors.

Registration is completed online directly between the student and LCCC. Megan Visniski, the LCCC Articulation Partnership Specialist, **will be at TAHS on February 19 for a 40-minute registration session.** Payment will be \$100 a credit or less and may be made later. A full copy of the DE agreement may be viewed on the high school counseling website under the dual enrollment tab.
