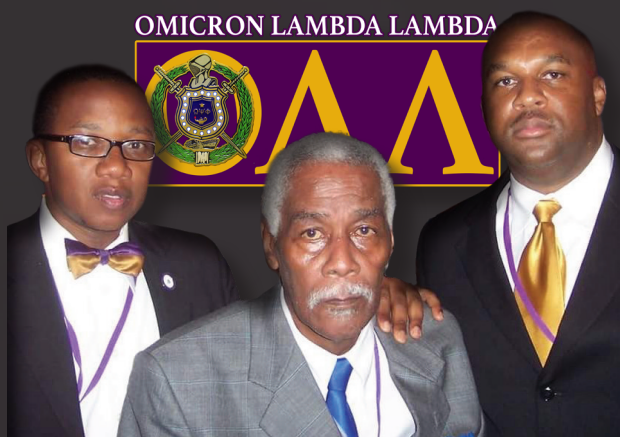

CHAPTER

Omicron Lambda Lambda chapter provides an opportunity for all brothers to align themselves together with other Omegas of like-minded methods of service, unity and brotherly pursuits that ensure a sustained, uplifting presence in Central Arkansas now and the future.

The conceptual thought of organizing an effort to seek and establish another chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Incorporated began on January 22, 2004. A small group of strong, enthusiastic Omega men collective saw a greater need for Omega's presence in the Central Arkansas area.

This group of brothers, spearheaded by elder statesmen Bro. Charles D. Thompson and Bro. Bruce Horton, began meeting regularly to discuss this endeavor. The brothers who participated in this initial concept were Reggie Davis, John Roberts, James O. Williams, Kevin Bell, and Edward Sherrill. The brothers decided that the idea of applying for the charter was a worthwhile effort.

The brothers incorporated the help of Bro. Don Davis, District Representative, to guide them through the charter application process. It was decided that the chapter would be established in Allport, Arkansas. This geographical location was selected to place the chapter in position to bring about an Omega presence to serve the Allport community as well as the communities of North Little Rock and North Pulaski County.



HISTORY

Omicron Lambda Lambda is one of the largest growing chapters in the state of Arkansas. This chapter has proven to be one of the top leaders in the areas of community service and scholarship.

Each year that it has existed, the brothers have offered food baskets to community residents in need during the Thanksgiving and Christmas seasons. Also, the brothers have volunteered to feed the hungry at the Watershed during the holidays. Annually, toys and bicycles are provided to children in our communities. Additionally,

Omicron Lambda Lambda has awarded over \$150,000 in scholarship funds to deserving graduating seniors. Every year, since 2004, this chapter has pushed health initiatives through community health fairs. Participants have been able to get screenings for breast cancer, prostate cancer, HIV, Cholesterol, blood pressure, and our legendary Charles Drew Blood Drive.

The chapter has provided mentorship to students at schools throughout Pulaski County. Additionally, the brothers have provided daily snacks for children with special needs at some of the local middle schools.

The Omicron Lambda Lambda Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Incorporated is continuing to thrive through Friendship. We are one of the most active Omega graduate chapters and we continue to grow in numbers. Our brotherhood is unified as we continue to uplift our communities through commitment and excellence!

OMEGA's turned Tampa purple and gold during the 84th Grand Conclave. It was the largest Grand Conclave to date and it was epic!

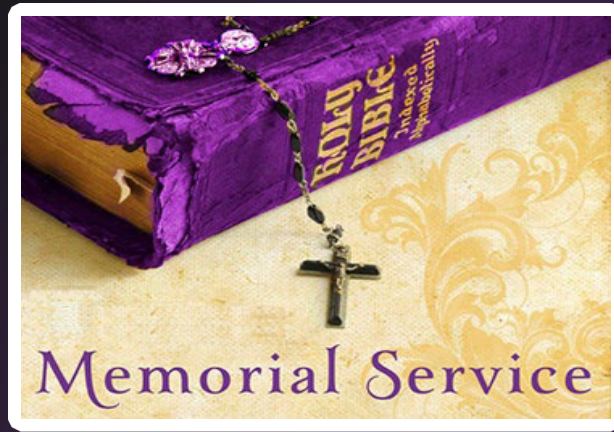
An historic 8,400 Omega men registered and attended the 84th Grand Conclave. An additional 3,000 Omega men were there to experience and show their expression of brotherhood.
