

INCOME AND ASSET LIMITS FOR PACE MEDICAID



PACE Southeast Michigan is a Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE). PACE Southeast Michigan uses Medicare, Medicaid and private funds to cover all medically necessary care and services for our participants.

To be a participant in the program at no cost, an individual must meet the income and asset limits for PACE Medicaid as determined by the State of Michigan.

Criteria

- 55 years of age and older
- Able to live safely in the community with the support of PACE Southeast Michigan
- Live in PACE Southeast Michigan assigned service area
- Meet nursing home level of care as defined by the State of Michigan
