Dental coverage

with \$0 copays on preventive care: 2 exams, 2 cleanings, and a set of bitewing x-rays every year; plus comprehensive services such as root canals simple extractions, fillings, crowns and crown repairs covered at 50% up to a \$2,000 benefit max



Vision coverage

with \$0 copays on routine exams and \$150 allowance/year for eyewear. Additional discounts may be offered on any balance over the allowance and on additional pairs of eyewear



Hearing coverage

with copays as low as \$0 and special copays on hearing aids depending on hearing aid selected

- Post-discharge meal benefit powered by Mom's Meals. Limited to 2 discharges per year of 28 meals/14 days; max of 56 meals per year.
- 12 one-way transportation trips to help you get to your medical appointments or to the pharmacy for \$0 copay
- Coverage extended to members during visits to Arizona, Florida, Michigan (out-of-service area) and Texas for up to 12 months
