ABOUT JEAN

-  Age: 75
-  Lives with her daughter, son-in-law, and two grandchildren
-  Diagnosed with dementia but still high functioning
-  Monthly Income: \$2,500
-  Insurance: Medicare and Medicaid
-  Family works full-time and grandchildren have after-school activities
-  Needs supervision and support throughout the day and evening

JEAN'S NEEDS

-  Daytime companionship and supervision
-  Structured, engaging environment
-  Assistance with meal preparation and bedtime routine
-  Occasional respite care when family travels

HOW PACE SUPPORTS JEAN

- Jean is picked up daily by Huron Valley PACE
- Attends the Day Center for activities, meals, bathing and memory care support
- Receives medical oversight and cognitive engagement
- Evening caregiver support to assist with dinner and bedtime on busy nights
- PACE provides respite care when the family travels for out-of-state basketball tournaments

BECAUSE OF PACE, JEAN'S FAMILY CAN...

- Work and manage family responsibilities with peace of mind
- Keep Jean safely living at home surrounded by loved ones
- Trust that care is continuous, reliable, and compassionate
