

PACE Southeast Michigan is a community-based program for people 55 years or older who meet the criteria for nursing facility placement but want to remain living in their homes. Our care team works with each participant to develop a personalized and comprehensive plan of care that promotes independence, safety, and dignity.

PACE Southeast Michigan is a Program for All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly, a national healthcare program funded by Medicare and Medicaid. PACE is a unique model of care as we become a participant's insurance and care provider. We use Medicare and Medicaid funds to cover all medically necessary care and services. Participants also have the option to privately pay.



Care doesn't have to wait for open enrollment!

Eligibility



To enroll, an individual must meet all the following:

- 1 55 years or older
- 2 Resident of Wayne, Oakland, or Macomb counties
- 3 Able to live safely in the community with the support of PACE
- 4 Meet the State of Michigan Level of Care Determination
