## Washington Mills Update

Design work continues on Phase 1 of Washington Mills Park, with the refined site layout approved by Town Council at the most recent meeting. Phase 1 focuses on core park infrastructure and recreational amenities supported by awarded grants, including pickleball and basketball courts, multi-use and natural surface walking trails, river access improvements, and stormwater bioretention features. Background information regarding the existing building was also provided for long-term planning purposes only, with no action or decision taken at this time.

Progress continues on the downtown sidewalk project along Main Street. Crews are working on excavation, grading, and concrete preparation to improve pedestrian safety and accessibility. Temporary traffic measures are in place for everyone's safety. Thank you for your patience as we work toward completion.
