



Community Update – Fire Incident at 800 S Ayersville Road

There is no danger to the public. The fire is out.

The 300-foot perimeter restriction has been released, and the road is open.

Air quality is fine. The NC Department of Environmental Quality (NCDEQ) is on scene, and Pilot Environmental Inc. is on scene handling cleanup.

The Fire Department will continue to monitor the site.

This is the final update on this incident. The Town will notify residents should anything change.
