**Toe-Tappin' Music "Out Wickenburg Way"**  
**RE: 47th Annual Wickenburg Bluegrass Festival**

The Four Corner States Wickenburg Bluegrass Festival is returning for its 47th year November 13-15, 2026! This festival is produced by the Wickenburg Chamber of Commerce and is one of the oldest bluegrass festivals in the Southwest. Whether you're a seasoned bluegrass connoisseur or just looking to enjoy a beautiful weekend out 'Wickenburg Way', music lovers of all ages are welcome to enjoy this toe-tappin', hand-clappin' bluegrass music festival.

This year promises to be better than ever with four bluegrass music bands gracing our stage. We are excited to welcome Permafrost Road, TenDollar Wedding, Cross-Eyed Possum, and the Badly Bent. Additionally, contestants will compete in eight categories for championship titles and over \$8,000 in cash prizes. Many of the categories bring championship designations, such as Fiddle, Mandolin, Flat Pick Guitar, and Banjo, with each champion taking home a minimum of \$600.

The Wickenburg Bluegrass Festival is held outdoors at the Everett Bowman Rodeo Grounds (935 Constellation Road) less than two miles from historic downtown Wickenburg. Reserved self-contained RV camping in Constellation Park is arranged through the Wickenburg Chamber of Commerce, as well as limited space in the tent camping area.

The festival weekend kicks off Friday at 11 a.m. with entertainment from 1 p.m. to 5p.m. On Saturday and Sunday, gates open at 8 a.m. for breakfast, and entertainment follows from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. This year we have teamed up with local partners to bring an all-new kid zone on Saturday and Sunday, so bring the kiddos!

Tickets for the Bluegrass Festival are: \$25 adults (18+), \$20 seniors (60+), \$15 students (6-17), children ages 5 and under are free. Three-day passes are \$60 adults, \$50 seniors, and \$40 students. Tickets are available online at [Eventbrite.com](https://www.eventbrite.com), at the Wickenburg Visitor Center, and at the gate on the day of the event.

While enjoying the music we encourage you to visit our festival vendors where you'll find yummy food, refreshing drinks, cold beers, and lots of shopping.

Outside alcoholic beverages, dogs, food, and coolers are prohibited. Spectators are encouraged to bring lawn chairs to sit in the arena, close to the stage. Covered grandstand bleacher seating is also available on a first come, first served basis.
