The annual Street Dance & Food Truck Fest will be bringing music and fun to historic downtown Wickenburg for its 22nd year.


This event is produced by the Wickenburg Chamber of Commerce.



Travel ID Deadline: May 2023

This is your reminder that starting May 3, 2023, all U.S. travelers will need a REAL ID compliant form of indentification to board a domestic flight.

Learn more and find out how to become REAL ID compliant on the Department of Homeland Security website: dhs.gov/real-id.

REAL ID cards will have one of the following star markings on the top portion of the card. If your card does not have one of these markings, it will not be accepted as proof of identity and you will not be able to board a domestic flight starting May 3, 2023.
