<p>I acknowledge that I have read, understood, and agree to abide by the terms and conditions of Override Skatepark and accept full responsibility for my actions (and/or those of my child) whilst using the facilities.</p> <p>I understand the risks involved in participating in a skatepark can result in injuries ranging from cuts and bruises to fractures, broken bones, and serious head injuries. Override operates a no-exception safety policy which requires that participants under 18 years MUST wear a helmet at all times whilst in the skatepark (available to hire). We strongly recommend the use of knee pads, elbow pads and gum shields (NOT available to hire).</p> <p>Parents/carers/guardians MUST NOT leave a child under age 10 unsupervised at Override. Where children 10 years and over are left unsupervised, please be aware that they remain the responsibility of the parent/carer/guardian. A parent/carer/guardian MUST leave contact details and be available to collect their child in the event of an accident or emergency.</p> <p>Override Skatepark is NOT a play area and must not be used as such. Override Skatepark is NOT a childcare facility and must not be used as such. Override skatepark have a trained first-aider on site at all times.</p> <p>Override cannot be held responsible for any items left unattended.</p> <p>Promotional video footage/photographs may be used by Override and shared with related companies (scooter/skateboard/inline etc).</p>

Terms and Conditions of Use;

1. You understand and recognise the high risk of injury with participation of urban sports such as BMX, skateboarding, Stunt Scooter and Roller blading. Override is an indoor skate park where people will try tricks and stunts which may go wrong causing injury to themselves. Accidents may occur due to the nature of the sport, which can include collision with others injuries may include cuts, scrapes, grazing, bruises, fractures, broken bones, head injury and even death. Override operate a strict rule of all participants must wear a helmet reducing the risk of head injury. By signing this form you agree to the provision of medical assistance by Overrides staff and or that of outside medical help, should it be necessary. You also therefore accept that Override shall not be held liable for any acts omissions or adverse results of any medical treatment administered.

At times Video footage and photographs are used to promote Override Skatepark which may also be shared with Companies dealing in BMX/Scooter etc. By signing the disclaimer form you are giving consent for us to use such imagery that may contain your child or yourself.

2. You agree to waive all liability claims against Cycle Route Ltd/Override Skate Park and its subsidiary and associated companies, its directors, employees and volunteers for any injuries, ailments or other damage to yourself , clothing or equipment whilst using Override Skate Park.

3. Participants of all ages are required to wear a safety helmet. Satisfactory safety equipment is recommended to be worn by all participants including gloves, wrist, knee, and elbow pads. All park users are required to sign the safety statement section of the parental consent form indemnifying Cycle Route Ltd and its subsidiary and associated companies, its directors, employees and volunteers for any injuries, ailments or other damage to yourself whilst using Override skate park.

4. We strongly recommend that participants wear full protective safety equipment, particularly wrist, knee, and elbow pads. If you do not you do so at your own risk.

5. You agree to conduct yourself according to the generally accepted rules of safe etiquette whilst participating in sessions within the skate park

6. You should not attempt to perform any manoeuvres you feel are beyond your skill level.

7. For safety and hygiene reasons no food or drink should be brought into the main part of skatepark

8. Children under the age of 10 years are to be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times whilst in Override skate park. If however you decide to leave your child unaccompanied you do so at your own risk. Children under the age of 4 are not allowed in the park except during certain sessions designed for that age group, please ask or see session schedule.

9. No throwing of objects, including helmets, bikes, skateboard etc.

10. Abusive, discourteous or otherwise anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated in or around Override Skatepark.

11. Litter, Vandalism or unauthorised graffiti will not be tolerated in or around Override Skatepark.

12. You Agree not to use Override whilst under the influence of drugs or alcohol. If suspected you will be refused entry to the Skatepark..

13. You agree to abide by instructions given by Override Skatepark staff, volunteers and stewards at all times.

14. Payment must be made prior to participating in any session.

15. No refunds will be given for those leaving a session prematurely.

16. Override Skatepark accepts no responsibility for the damage, loss or theft of any personal belongings brought into the Skatepark. Personal belongings should not be left unattended anywhere in or around the park.

17. Failure to abide by these generally accepted terms and conditions and to falsify consent/member information will result in refusal of entry. Repeat violators may be asked to leave the park and may incur a lifetime ban.

18. The management reserve the right to refuse entry at any point and to change the terms and conditions of entry



You **must** read this before you enter the Skate Park!

Override Skate Park Safety Rules

- We strongly recommend that all participants using the Skate Park wear full protective equipment at all time. Particularly wrist, knee and elbow pads.
- Participants of all ages are **required to wear a helmet** NO EXCEPTIONS!
- It is your responsibility to ensure your equipment is in good working order with no loose parts.
- No sitting or gathering on the ramps. Use the rest spaces provided!
- Spectators must stay in designated areas provided. Entry into the skate park is not allowed.
- No food or drink to be taken into the main Skate Park area.
- Vandalism will not be tolerated. Anyone aware of on-going vandalism must report it to a member of staff immediately.
- Violence, bullying or anti-social behaviour of any sort will not be tolerated.
- No Skating, Riding or Scooting except in the main Skate Park Area.
- Fire Exits and information about how to react in the event of a fire are on display around the Skate Park. If you are unsure about where this information is, please see a member of staff.
- No tampering with fire extinguishers or fire alarms except in the event of a fire. A surcharge will be enforced if you fail to comply.
- Staff must be obeyed at all times and reserve the right to remove anyone from the facility at their discretion.
- Alcohol must not be consumed on the premises or before entry to the park. Anybody deemed intoxicated will be refused entry to the park.
- Drug use or possession will not be tolerated.
- Be aware of fellow participants in the park at all times
- Theft from the park, shop or fellow participants will result in the police being called.
- Smoking is prohibited anywhere within the building.
- Know your limitations. You use the Override Skate Park at your own risk. Extreme sports in this sort of purpose built environment can cause serious injury or even death!
- Any injury that may occur in the Skate Park must be reported to reception. The accident will be recorded and must be signed by the injured person or their representative.
- Do not leave personal belongings lying around. Space is provided behind the main reception
- Under 16's must have a consent form signed by either parent or guardian.
- All Participants, (Including spectators) must sign in at the reception. Failure to do so will be regarded by the management as trespass.
