The Church gets a Spring Clean If you can't see the difference in church today you should certainly be able to smell it! All areas of the sanctuary and body of the church have been dry cleaned by **zero dry time** who clean the Little Sisters Chapel: hence the recommendation. They have made a fantastic job and it has removed any feisty odours emanating from the carpet after many a water stain from leaks over the years. (We will have to repeat the collection every quarter to try to raise sufficient funds to pay our way In the past this cost has been paid directly from Parish funds but this is becoming too onerous. Please note the totals raised for 2nd collections are now posted at the back of church on the Sunday following the collection.
