General Price List

These prices are effective as of February 1st, 2026, and are subject to change without notice.

The products and services contained in this price list are those we provide for our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. All funeral arrangements selected will include a charge for our services. If legal or other requirements necessitate the purchase of any items you did not specifically request, the funeral home will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. There may be additional charges for certain items outside the control of the funeral home. These items include, but are not limited to, floral arrangements, religious honorariums, obituary notices, death certificates, funeral procession escorts, medical examiner authorization fee (for cremations), and cemetery fee. A Statement of Funeral Goods and Services (funeral contract) will be provided at the time of the arrangement. Please keep a copy. We are not responsible for lost or misplaced documents.

You will note that we offer personalized service packages. The Funeral Director handling your arrangements will further explain our personalized service packages.

PAYMENT POLICY

All charges are due and payable at the arrangement conference. You may choose from one of the following payment options:

- Fully Funded Pre-Arranged Funeral
- Cash, Money Orders, Cashier's Checks
- Personal Checks (Must clear prior to services being finalized)
- Assignment of a verified insurance policy

If choosing an insurance option, please be aware of the following rules:

A fee of 6% (of the itemized statement of goods and services) will be added to process the claim.

Insurance policy and beneficiary information must be verified with the insurance company prior to scheduling of services. This cannot normally be accomplished on a weekend/holiday.

The beneficiary of the policy must be the buyer.

All cash advance items are due and payable at the arrangement conference. If necessary, a credit card number will be required to pay for any incidentals such as local and out-of-town newspapers, etc.

We do not invoice estates.

Funeral Procession Policy

An important part of the funeral service is the procession of the family and guests that accompany the deceased to the cemetery. Traffic and safety concerns for the mourners and their guests require formal funeral processions to be escorted by two or more licensed motorcade escorts.

Licensed motorcade escorts enable Serenity Funeral Home and Cremation personnel to assemble the funeral procession, hold lights at intersections, and have everyone arrive at the cemetery/church at the same time. (Police escorts are the only ones that may interrupt traffic)

If no funeral escorts have been arranged for, directions to the cemetery/church will be furnished as needed but no procession can be formed.

Local Police and Private Funeral Escort Companies may be contracted and will be billed at actual cost. Serenity Funeral Home and Cremation is not responsible for their fees, the maximum number of vehicles they will accept in a procession, and any rules or regulations that they will impose as part of their services.

Clergy · Officiant · Celebrant

You will need one person to take charge of and oversee the ceremony. This person is responsible for starting and finishing the service, conducting prayers, reading and/or blessings, delivering the eulogy if asked and coordinating all the activities in between. Most families engage a clergy, officiant or master of ceremony to serve as the master of ceremonies during the services.

Services need not be religious. You may have a family member or friend conduct the services or decide not to have any formal services.

If you choose to have clergy, we encourage you to contact the place of worship which you attend and plan.

Serenity Funeral Home can help the family if needed, by providing a clergy contact list. Family member(s) must contact and confirm with the clergy directly. Any stipends and or donations requested/required by clergy are the sole responsibility of the individual requesting the services.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

\$2,495

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains). This fee includes the following:

Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial call; Arrangement conference/consultation with the family; Obtaining necessary authorizations and signatures; Preparing and filing death certificate and notifying social security; Coordinating with Crematory/Cemetery to provide portions of the requested services; proportionate share of our basic overhead costs, facility maintenance, administration expenses and governmental compliance.

Preparation of the Deceased

Embalming is a chemical process which provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with extended viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Immediate Burial \$3,495

(No Services, No Ceremony, Funeral Director, and Staff Only at Cemetery)

Our charge for an immediate burial (without any ceremonies at the funeral home, graveside, or elsewhere) include basic services of funeral director and staff for immediate burial, refrigeration, transfer of remains from place of death to funeral home within 35 miles of funeral home, and transportation of remains to cemetery.

Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Home **\$3,495**

This charge includes transfer of remains to our funeral home, obtaining required authorizations, basic services of funeral director and staff, embalming/other preparation of remains, refrigeration, and transportation to the local airport (MIA / FLL / Palm Beach).

This charge does not include visitation or ceremonies, cash advance items, or any funeral merchandise. International shipments will incur additional charges depending on the requirements of the receiving country, such as apostilles, consulate fees, or certified translations.

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home **\$3,195**

This charge includes the basic services of the funeral director and staff, transportation of remains from the local airport (MIA / FLL / Palm Beach), and transportation to the cemetery or crematory (within a 35-mile radius).

This charge does not include use of facilities and staff for visitation, funeral ceremonies, cash advance items, or any cemetery or crematory fees.

Anatomical Donation **\$2,595**

This Charge includes basic services of the Funeral Director & staff, embalming/preparation of deceased, transfer of remains to funeral home, and transfer to anatomical donation.

*This service does not include Use of funeral home facilities for any visitation or funeral ceremony, merchandise selected such as casket, containers, prayer cards, register books, and any additional merchandise you may select, or cemetery and crematory fees.

Direct Cremation

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials. The containers we provide are either fiberboard containers, wood, or combustible plastic materials. We offer a selection of cremation-oriented caskets.

Our charges for direct cremation without ceremony include Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff for Direct Cremation, refrigeration (10-day maximum), transport to our crematory and cremation process.

Direct Cremation with container provided by purchaser **\$1,995**

Purchasers may provide their own container. All such containers must meet any applicable state and crematory requirement.

Direct Cremation with cardboard container from our facility **\$2,190**

Starmark alternative cremation container with a heavy cardboard exterior and no interior.

*Standard cremation is based on the deceased weighing 300 pounds or less and not having any implanted devices such as pacemakers or pumps that have batteries. Additional fees apply for decedents over 300 pounds and residential transfer due to additional personnel and/or equipment needed.
