What to expect in our Faith Formation K through 3 - meets on either Tuesday OR Wednesday afternoons from 4:30-5:45pm. Class time is approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes.

Your child will need to be signed in and out. Please wait to drop off your child until their teacher arrives. In addition K-1 children focus on Gospel stories and prayers. 2nd grade focuses on studying the reconciliation sacrament, and 3rd grade focuses on studying the sacrament of 1st Eucharist.

What to expect in our 4/5 Grade Grooted Program - meets on Thursdays at 4:30-5:45pm. Grooted or God-Rooted is a youth ministry style program focused on the Saints and Sacraments. We will be meeting together in a large group for games and activities and meeting in small groups for sharing and learning. Every week those attending will receive a Saint card. If you miss you miss out! We include a snack, so don't forget to let us know about any food allergies and if you can bring pretzels, cheez-its, goldfish or fruit on occasion we would appreciate the help.

What to expect in Middle School - meets on Mondays from 4:30-5:45 pm. The goal is to root our middle school kids in their faith and build a community with one another. Even though Middle School is not a sacramental prep program, it's so important for our youth to stay connected in the church community! We include a snack, so don't forget to let us know about any food allergies and if you can bring pretzels, cheez-its, goldfish, oreos or fruit on occasion we would appreciate the help.

What to expect in the Confirmation Program - Our Confirmation program meets every Sunday for three years and goes from 6:30-8 pm. We feed the kids a light dinner and ask each family to bring food for 10 with your child's class 5-6 times a year. Our topic for 1st year is Theology of the Body, 2nd year is the History of the Church and The final year is about service. Your child will learn about the Ministries of the church and have the opportunity to volunteer. In addition to regular class attendance, We require a one time retreat during the confirmation preparation.

What to expect in our Youth Ministry program - Open to all 13 - 18 Year Old Students Activity TBD on a weekly basis. The goal is to help strengthen our teen community at the parish through faith sharing and fun events! It's an awesome opportunity to get to know other teens at our parish and have a ton of fun!. We have faith nights, go out to different activities (bowling, movies, etc.), service projects and more.

*** Sacramental parents: 1st Reconciliation, 1st communion, Parents must attend 2 Bible Studies, or 2 Rosaries a month, Or attend one of the Three Missions located on the calendar.**

***3rd year Confirmation parents must attend one of the Three Missions located on the calendar.**
