

## Equine Rehabilitation Livery – Terms & Conditions

At **Restore & Enhance Animal Physiotherapy**, our Equine Rehabilitation Livery is designed to provide **safe, structured, veterinary-led rehabilitation** in a calm and professional environment. The summary below highlights the key points owners should be aware of before admission.

### Veterinary-Led Rehabilitation

- All horses must be under the care of a **registered veterinary surgeon**.
  - Written veterinary consent or referral is required prior to admission.
  - I work closely with your vet and other professionals involved in your horse's care.
  - In an emergency, I am authorised to obtain veterinary treatment in the horse's best interests.

### Individual Rehabilitation Programmes

- Every rehabilitation programme is **tailored to the individual horse**.
  - Plans may include controlled exercise, hands-on physiotherapy, use of the horse walker, poles, school, solarium, and therapeutic modalities such as laser.
  - Programmes are reviewed regularly and may change depending on progress, veterinary advice, or welfare considerations.
  - Rehabilitation outcomes cannot be guaranteed.

### Admission Requirements

- Owners must complete all required **pre-admission forms and questionnaires** before arrival.
  - Horses must arrive fit to travel, with up-to-date **influenza and tetanus vaccinations**.
  - Any medical history, medication, or behavioural concerns must be fully disclosed.
- 

### Length of Stay

- Rehabilitation stays are agreed in advance but remain **flexible**.
  - Stays may be extended or shortened based on clinical progress.
  - Early removal does not remove the obligation to pay agreed fees.

## Owner Visits & Communication

- Visits are by appointment only to ensure safety and minimise disruption to rehabilitation routines.
  - Owners must not handle, exercise, or treat their horse during the stay unless agreed in writing.
  - Regular updates will be provided at agreed intervals.

## Fees & Payments

- Fees are charged in line with our published **Rehabilitation Livery Price List**.
- Payment is required in advance unless otherwise agreed.
- Veterinary fees, farriery, medication, and additional services are charged separately.

## What's included in Rehabilitation Livery Pricing

- Bedding: 1 bale of shavings per week included.
- Forage: up to 0.5 small square bale of hay per day included.

## What's not included in Rehabilitation Livery Pricing

- Feed, supplements or treats are not included.
- Haylage is not provided.

## Additional Forage & Bedding

- Owners may supply their own haylage, which can be stored on site by arrangement
- Additional hay is charged at **£5 per bale**
- Additional bedding is charged at **£10 per bale** (shavings or wood pellets)

Please contact me to discuss your horse's individual requirements if alternative forage and bedding is required.

## Welfare & Safety

- Horse welfare is my highest priority.
  - I reserve the right to adapt routines, exercise, turnout, or rehabilitation plans in the horse's best interests.
  - Rehabilitation involves inherent risk due to the nature of horses, despite all reasonable care being taken.

## **Risk & Insurance**

- Horses are cared for at the **owner's risk**.
  - While I hold appropriate public liability insurance, owners are strongly advised to maintain their own insurance for veterinary fees, mortality, and third-party liability.
  - I cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to rugs, tack, or personal belongings.

## **Removal & Termination**

- I reserve the right to end a rehabilitation stay if fees remain unpaid, safety is compromised, or welfare concerns arise.
  - Horses must be removed promptly once deemed fit to travel.

## **Legal**

- Our rehabilitation livery operates under the laws of **England and Wales**.
  - Admission confirms acceptance of our full Terms & Conditions.
