







THE MICROWEIGHT STRUCTURE (MWS) BUILDING TECHNOLOGY

BB Wong Inc. forms a strategic alliance with the <u>IDEA Project</u> for affordable shelter called the MicroWeight Structure (MWS) building technology, a revolution in creating 'space'.



The MWS employs an ancient geometric design used for hundreds of years when building structures in a new manner to create a portable yet permanent building structure.

The MWS uses three different modular components, (foundation, wall, roof) to make any size structure using more or less of each component.

The MWS can be assembled and disassembled quickly, and then 'sandwiched' neatly in a transportation container for shipment anywhere.

Any size MWS can be erected from the foundation upwards eliminating cranes and additional labor costs.

The initial rollout for the MWS is targeted to the emergency, homeless and refugee shelter marketplace.

Opportunities are now open to qualified investors to complete the ninth MWS prototype to be used as marketing platforms in North America and the African Continent.
