DID YOU KNOW? U.S. LABOR HISTORY

After the Haymarket Affair, though labor organizers in countries around the world began celebrating May 1 as Workers Day, U.S. government officials had no interest in sanctioning it. Meanwhile, other cities had followed New York's lead in holding Labor Day celebrations in early September. In 1887, Oregon became the first state to make it an official holiday; by 1894, 22 other states had passed similar legislation.
