

COVID - 19 Update and Procedures for 2022-23

For the 2022-23 school year we will continue to:

- Employ day porters to work throughout each building cleaning/wiping down touchable surfaces during the school day.
- Provide an air purifying system for each teaching space as well as common spaces in each building.
- Provide hand sanitizer and encourage hand washing often.
- Ask that if your child is sick, please stay home, we are asking the same from our staff.
- We will monitor outbreaks if they occur at specific sites, and work with the Weld County Health Department to provide guidance if this should happen.

Following CDC's guidelines for a positive case.

- If you test positive (vaccinated or not), you will need to stay home from school as well as other school activities and isolate yourself for five days from symptom onset. A negative retest will not allow an earlier return to school. You may return to school on day six if the following have occurred:
 - Fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.
 - Your symptoms are improving.
- We recommend that you wear a mask through day ten.
- We will <u>not</u> be tracking exposures, or close contacts moving forward. If you know you are exposed, we recommend you monitor yourself for symptoms.
