Participate in BOTH Preparation Sessions:

Parent/Child Session #1: Thursday, October 15, 2026 6:00pm – 7:30pm

AND

Parent/Child Session #2: Wednesday, November 18, 2026 6:00pm – 7:30pm

Participate in EITHER First Reconciliation Celebration:

Saturday, January 9, 2027 10:00am

OR

Wednesday, January 13, 2027 6:00pm

The following dates are for the preparation and celebration for First Communion.

Participate in BOTH Preparation Sessions:

Parent/Child Session: Wednesday, February 24, 2027 6:00pm – 7:30pm

AND

Breadbaking Retreat & Family Lunch: Saturday, April 10, 2027 9:00am – 1:00pm

Participate in EITHER First Communion Celebration/Rehearsal:

Saturday, May 1st 5:00pm Mass with rehearsal Tuesday, April 27th: 6:00pm

OR

Sunday, May 2nd 10:45am Mass with rehearsal Wednesday, April 28th: 6:00pm

You will notice there are two dates listed for each celebration. You will be able to request your choice of First Reconciliation celebration in the registration form that will be emailed in the fall. Registration for First Communion preparation will be sent in January, at which time you will be able to indicate your preference of First Communion Mass.
