A Welcome to a Life of Faith...

Baptism is the first important step a parent takes to begin the lifelong process of faith formation for their child. When a child is baptized he or she receives the light of Christ's love and is welcomed into the faith community. At the same time parents are making a commitment to raise their child in faith.

GETTING READY FOR BAPTISM

Parents who wish to have a child baptized at St. Anthony are asked to participate in a Baptism Preparation class. These sessions are held every other month, usually on a Sunday morning.

Baptism class is for first time parents and parents who have not had a child baptized at St. Anthony to prepare for the ritual. The focus is on understanding the theology of Baptism, the meaning behind the symbols and ritual, as well as an introduction to the role of parents in their child's faith formation.

At these sessions you will meet other parents who have children the same age as yours. You will learn about many of the opportunities for social and spiritual connections with other parents and for your child in the church. It is an awesome responsibility to cultivate the faith of our children. This will be a time to renew your commitment to help your child grow in God's love and to learn how to become part of the St. Anthony faith community.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- * Register for Baptism Preparation session
- * Schedule Baptism date
- * Choose Godparents
 - Only one is required, no more than two are allowed
 - When having two sponsors, one must be male and one female
 - One must be a confirmed practicing Catholic
 - Sponsors must be 16 years old
