As I begin my new role as principal of St. Anthony on the Lake, I truly believe that my educational and professional journey has led me to this time and place, and I feel incredibly blessed.

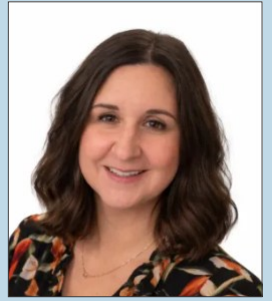

You'll find books in our Parish Library on the basics of our Catholic Faith, books about why it's great to be Catholic, and more about Catholic Traditions.

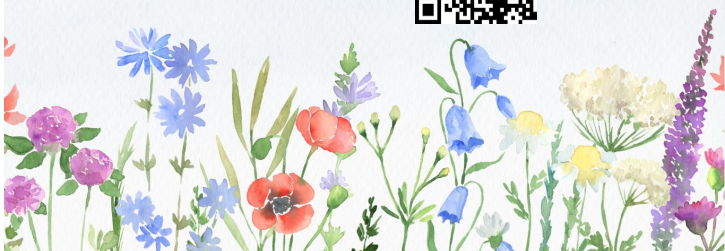

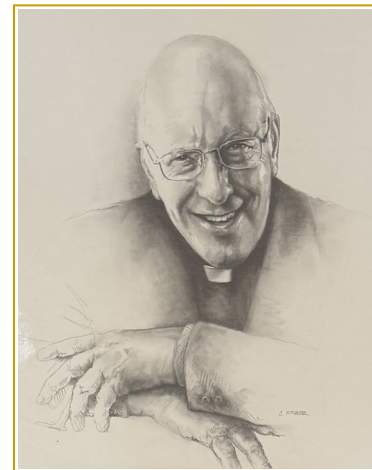

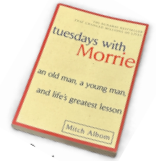

Bible Camp Peace Sculpture on Display in the Gathering Space

The theme of being a peacemaker was woven into every aspect of this year's Bible Camp. The 4th and 5th graders learned that an origami paper crane is one symbol of peace. They researched the Children's Peace Monument in Hiroshima, Japan, which is dedicated to a young girl who began folding 1,000 paper cranes. Others then learned to make their own origami cranes.

The younger children learned the dove is also a symbol of peace. They painted paper doves with watercolors. The doves were then strung with the cranes to create our *St. Anthony's Peace Sculpture*.
