St. Vincent de Paul Meal Program
2026 Food Donator Items

1. DESSERT –approx. 12 servings. Home baked items MAY again be donated
 - a. Other Ideas: “Little Debbie,” “Hostess” type products, granola bars, fruit snacks & muffins
2. SAUCE-Two **PLASTIC** jars of either Prego or Ragu spaghetti sauce. Or 2 jars of nacho cheese sauce. Quart jars preferred as large ones are too heavy.
3. THIN SPAGHETTI – Two 1-pound boxes of thin spaghetti noodles NOT COOKED.
4. DINNER ROLLS – Two dozen small baked dinner rolls. *No ovens are used at the site.
5. SALAD TOPPINGS-
 - a. First five people in the group: 1 package of shredded carrots
 - b. Next five people in the group: canister of grated Parmesan Cheese
 - c. Remainder of group: 2 pints of cherry or grape tomatoes
6. SALAD ITEMS-
 - a. First 10 people in group: 2 bottles of Ranch dressing
 - b. Remainder of group: 16 oz of shredded cheddar cheese
7. FRESH FRUIT – softer types of fruit are appreciated due to dental challenges
 - a. Ideas: 3 lb bag of oranges, tangerines or ‘Cuties’, 12 bananas, or 12 fruit cups
8. BEVERAGES- 12 juice boxes
9. LETTUCE SALAD - \$5.00 donation for fresh lettuce salad.
 - a. Please place money in an envelope and place in black mailbox on the wall outside the parish office and make sure to label SALAD DONATION.
10. PUDDING CUPS – 12 non-refrigerated pudding cups, any flavor.
11. PAPER PRODUCTS or TRASH BAGS – 2 packages of paper towels, OR 2 packages of toilet paper (4 roll per package), OR one box of 30-gallon heavy duty trash bags.
12. LAUNDRY SOAP – One SMALL size bottle OR one SMALL box of laundry detergent, or Tide pods (20 count), or dryer sheets.
13. HYGIENE ITEMS –
 - a. Ideas:
 - i. Several SAMPLE SIZE of shampoo, bar soap, deodorant or toothpaste
 - ii. 1 toothbrush with holder or cap
 - iii. One package of baby wipes
 - iv. Mints or gum or chapstick or Carmex
 - b. Note: Think camping in the rough and anything you would use in that situation - even homed guests may not have electricity, running water, laundry, etc.
14. MEAT- \$5.00- ground beef will be purchased and cooked at the meal site by their staff.
 - a. Please place money in an envelope and place in black mailbox on the wall outside the parish office and make sure to label BEEF.

Please bring all items to the Fellowship Hall Kitchen by 12:30 PM on Sunday afternoon. Items needing to be refrigerated should be placed in the refrigerator in the kitchen. Other items may be put on the counter in the kitchen. Please label donations ‘SVDP’. THANK YOU!!
