This document explains how we collect, use, store, and protect your personal information. By continuing to access or use our website, you acknowledge that you have read and understood this Policy and agree to its terms. If you do not agree, please discontinue use of the site immediately.

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy describes the types of information we collect, the purposes for which we use it, how we protect it, and the choices and rights available to you. It applies to all visitors, users, and customers who access or use the Site, regardless of their location.

This Policy is incorporated into, and forms part of, our Terms of Service. By using the Site, you consent to the data practices described in this Policy. If you provide us with information on behalf of another individual, you confirm

that you have their authorization to do so and that they have been informed of the contents of this Policy.

We take your privacy seriously. We do not sell your personal data to third parties, and we do not use it in ways beyond those described in this Policy without first obtaining your consent.

2. Information We Collect

We collect information from you in several ways — some you provide directly, and some is gathered automatically when you use the Site. The categories of information we may collect include the following:

2.1 Personal Identification Information

When you create an account, make a purchase, or contact us, you may provide us with personal details such as:

- Full name
- Email address
- Phone number
- Billing and shipping address
- Company name or job title (if applicable)
- Username and password for account registration

2.2 Automatically Collected Data

When you visit the Site, our servers and analytics tools may automatically collect certain technical information, including:

- IP address and approximate geographic location derived from it
- Browser type and version
- Operating system and device type

- Pages visited, links clicked, and time spent on each page
- Date and time stamps of your visits
- Referring website or URL (how you arrived at our Site)
- Internet service provider (ISP)

This information is collected to help us understand how the Site is being used, to improve performance, and to diagnose technical issues. It is generally not linked to a specific individual unless combined with personal identification information.

2.3 Information You Provide Voluntarily

You may choose to provide additional information when you:

- Submit an inquiry or message through a contact form
- Sign up for our email newsletter or mailing list
- Register for an account or membership
- Participate in surveys, contests, or promotions
- Post comments, reviews, or other user-generated content on the Site

The information you provide in these contexts is used only for the purposes for which it was submitted, unless we obtain your consent for other uses.

2.4 Payment Information

If you make a purchase through the Site, any payment information you provide — such as credit card numbers, billing addresses, and transaction details — is processed directly by our trusted third-party payment processor(s). We do not store, handle, or have direct access to your full payment card details. All payment transactions are encrypted and governed by the privacy policies of the applicable payment processor. You are encouraged to review their policies before completing a transaction.

3. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect for lawful, specific, and transparent purposes. These include:

- **Providing and improving our services:** To operate, maintain, and enhance the Site and the products or services we offer, including personalizing your experience where applicable.
- **Processing transactions:** To fulfill orders, process payments, send order confirmations, and manage returns or refunds.
- **Marketing and promotional communications:** To send you newsletters, product updates, special offers, or other information we believe may interest you — but only where you have opted in or where permitted by applicable law. You may opt out of marketing emails at any time by clicking the "unsubscribe" link in any email we send, or by contacting us directly at **[Your Contact Email]**.
- **Responding to inquiries and support requests:** To communicate with you, answer your questions, and provide customer support.
- **Analyzing usage patterns and site performance:** To understand how visitors interact with the Site, identify popular content, measure the effectiveness of features, and make data-driven improvements.
- **Legal compliance and fraud prevention:** To comply with applicable laws and regulations, enforce our Terms of Service, detect and prevent fraudulent or unauthorized activity, and protect the rights, property, and safety of our users and the public.
- **Internal record keeping:** To maintain accurate business records and fulfill our legal and regulatory obligations.

We will not use your personal information for any purpose that is incompatible with the purposes stated above without first obtaining your consent or as otherwise required by law.

4. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

4.1 What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device (computer, tablet, or smartphone) when you visit a website. They allow the website to recognize your device, remember your preferences, and collect information about how you use the site. Cookies do not contain executable code and cannot access other data stored on your device.

4.2 How We Use Cookies

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies (such as web beacons and pixel tags) to operate and improve the Site. The categories of cookies we use are as follows:

- **Essential / Functional Cookies:** These cookies are strictly necessary for the Site to function properly. They enable core features such as page navigation, secure login, shopping cart functionality, and access to protected areas of the Site. The Site cannot function correctly without these cookies, and they cannot be disabled without significantly impacting your experience.
- **Analytics Cookies:** These cookies collect aggregated, anonymous information about how visitors use the Site — such as which pages are visited most often, how long users stay on each page, and any error messages encountered. This data helps us understand user behavior and improve site performance. We use tools such as Google Analytics for this purpose (see Section 5).

- **Marketing / Advertising Cookies:** These cookies are used to deliver advertisements that are relevant to you and your interests, and to measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns. They may be placed by us or by third-party advertising networks. These cookies track your browsing activity across websites and may build a profile of your interests over time.

4.3 Controlling Cookies

You have the right to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers are set to accept cookies by default, but you can modify your browser settings to decline cookies or to alert you when cookies are being sent. Please be aware that disabling certain cookies may affect the functionality of the Site.

To manage cookies in your browser, please refer to your browser's help documentation:

- Google Chrome: Settings > Privacy and Security > Cookies and other site data
- Mozilla Firefox: Options > Privacy & Security > Cookies and Site Data
- Microsoft Edge: Settings > Privacy, search, and services > Cookies and site permissions
- Apple Safari: Preferences > Privacy > Manage Website Data

4.4 Third-Party Cookies

Certain features of the Site may involve the placement of cookies by third parties, such as Google Analytics, social media platforms, or advertising networks. These third parties have their own privacy policies governing the use of such cookies, and we do not control how they operate. We encourage you to review the privacy policies of any third-party services you interact with through our Site.

5. Analytics

We use third-party analytics services — including but not limited to **Google Analytics** — to help us understand how visitors interact with the Site. These tools collect and report information anonymously or in aggregate form, helping us make informed decisions about content, design, and functionality.

5.1 Data Collected by Analytics Tools

Analytics tools may collect the following types of information:

- Number of page views and unique visitors
- Session duration and average time spent on pages
- Bounce rate (percentage of visitors who leave after viewing one page)
- Traffic sources and referral URLs
- Geographic location (country or region level only)
- Device type, browser, and operating system
- User flow and navigation paths through the Site

5.2 IP Anonymization

Where technically possible and required by applicable law, we have enabled IP address anonymization (also known as IP masking) in our analytics configuration. This means that the last portion of a user's IP address is masked before it is stored by the analytics provider, reducing the ability to identify individual users by their IP address alone.

5.3 Opting Out of Analytics

If you do not wish to have your site visit data collected by Google Analytics, you may install the **Google Analytics Opt-out Browser Add-on**, available at no cost from Google. This add-on prevents the Google Analytics JavaScript from sharing information about your visit. Additionally, you may manage

cookie preferences through your browser settings as described in Section 4.3.

Opting out of analytics tracking does not affect your ability to use the Site or any of its features.

6. Third-Party Sharing and Disclosure

We respect your privacy. We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information to third parties for their marketing purposes. We may share your information only in the limited circumstances described below:

- **Service Providers and Vendors:** We may share your information with trusted third-party companies that perform services on our behalf, such as website hosting providers, payment processors, email delivery services, customer support platforms, and data analytics providers. These service providers are contractually obligated to use your information only for the purposes of providing services to us and to maintain appropriate security and confidentiality standards.
- **Legal Requirements:** We may disclose your information if required to do so by law, or in response to valid legal process such as a subpoena, court order, or government request. We may also disclose information where we believe disclosure is necessary to protect the legal rights, safety, or property of [Your Company Name], our users, or the public.
- **Business Transfers:** In the event of a merger, acquisition, reorganization, sale of substantially all assets, or bankruptcy involving [Your Company Name], your personal information may be transferred to the successor entity as part of that transaction. - **Right to Deletion ("Right to Be Forgotten"):** You may request that we delete your personal information where it is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected, where you withdraw consent and no other legal basis applies, or where the data has been processed unlawfully. Please note that certain legal obligations may require us to retain some information.

- **Right to Data Portability:** Where technically feasible and legally applicable, you have the right to receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format, and to transmit that data to another service provider.
- **Right to Withdraw Consent:** Where our processing of your personal information is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing that occurred before the withdrawal.
- **Right to Object or Restrict Processing:** In certain circumstances, you have the right to object to our processing of your personal information or to request that we restrict how we use it while a dispute is resolved.
- **Right to Lodge a Complaint:** If you believe that we have handled your personal information in a manner that violates applicable law, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the relevant data protection supervisory authority in your country or region.

7.1 Jurisdiction-Specific Rights

The rights described above may vary in scope depending on your jurisdiction:

- **European Union / EEA Users (GDPR):** If you are located in the European Union or European Economic Area, your rights are governed by the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). You have the full range of rights described above. Our legal bases for processing your data may include your consent, performance of a contract, compliance with a legal obligation, or our legitimate interests.
- **California Residents (CCPA / CPRA):** If you are a California resident, you have rights under the California Consumer Privacy Act

(CCPA) and the California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA), including the right to know what personal information is collected, the right to delete personal information, the right to opt out of the sale or sharing of personal information, and the right not to be discriminated against for exercising your privacy rights. We do not sell personal information as defined under California law.

- **Other Jurisdictions:** Residents of other jurisdictions may have additional rights under local law. We will endeavor to honor all valid legal requests consistent with applicable regulations.

7.2 How to Exercise Your Rights

To exercise any of the rights described above, please contact us by email at **[Your Contact Email]** with a clear description of your request and sufficient information for us to identify you in our records. We will respond to your request within 30 days of receipt, unless a longer period is permitted by applicable law. We will not charge a fee for reasonable requests unless they are manifestly unfounded or excessive.

8. Data Retention

We retain personal information only for as long as is necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, to meet our legal and regulatory obligations, to resolve disputes, and to enforce our agreements. When information is no longer required for any of these purposes, it is securely deleted or anonymized.

The criteria we use to determine appropriate retention periods include:

- The nature and sensitivity of the personal information
- The purposes for which it was collected and whether those purposes have been fulfilled

- Applicable legal, regulatory, tax, or accounting requirements
- Whether a legal dispute, complaint, or investigation is pending or reasonably foreseeable
- Whether you have exercised your right to deletion and no overriding legal obligation applies

For example, account information is typically retained for the duration of your active account plus a reasonable period thereafter. Transaction records may be retained for up to seven (7) years for financial and tax compliance purposes. Marketing consent records are retained until you withdraw your consent.

If you submit a valid request for deletion of your personal data, we will process that request promptly and confirm completion in writing. Some data may be retained in anonymized or aggregated form for analytical purposes even after individual records are deleted.

9. Security Measures

We take the security of your personal information seriously and have implemented a range of technical, organizational, and procedural measures designed to protect your data from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. These measures include:

- **SSL/TLS Encryption in Transit:** All data transmitted between your browser and our Site is encrypted using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) or Transport Layer Security (TLS) protocols, as indicated by the "https://" prefix and padlock icon in your browser's address bar.
- **Encrypted Storage for Sensitive Data at Rest:** Sensitive personal information stored in our systems, including account credentials and

payment-related data, is protected using industry-standard encryption algorithms.

- **Access Controls and Authentication:** Access to personal data within our organization is restricted on a need-to-know basis. Staff who handle personal data are required to use strong, unique passwords and, where available, multi-factor authentication.
- **Regular Security Audits and Vulnerability Assessments:** We conduct periodic reviews and assessments of our systems to identify and remediate potential security vulnerabilities before they can be exploited.
- **Employee Training:** All staff members who handle personal data receive training on data protection principles, responsible data handling practices, and how to recognize and respond to potential security threats.
- **Incident Response Procedures:** We maintain documented procedures for detecting, responding to, and reporting data security incidents. In the event of a data breach that poses a risk to your rights and freedoms, we will notify affected individuals and relevant regulatory authorities as required by applicable law.

Important Disclaimer:

While we make every reasonable effort to protect your personal information, no method of electronic transmission or storage is 100% secure. We cannot guarantee the absolute security of your data and encourage you to take precautions on your end, such as using strong passwords and keeping your login credentials confidential.

10. Children's Privacy

Our Site is not directed to, intended for, or designed to attract children. Specifically:

- The Site is not directed at children under the age of **13** (or under the age of **16** for users in the European Union, in accordance with GDPR requirements).
- We do not knowingly collect personal information from children below these age thresholds.
- We do not knowingly allow children to register for accounts or submit information through our forms.

We encourage you to review this Policy periodically to stay informed about how we are protecting your information. Your continued use of the Site following the posting of any revised Privacy Policy constitutes your

acknowledgment of the changes and your agreement to be bound by the updated terms.

If you do not agree with the revised Policy, you should discontinue use of the Site and, if applicable, close your account and request deletion of your personal data in accordance with Section 7.
