Assessments

Multiplication Tables Check

- Checks for all pupils to be carried out within a 2-week period from Monday 7th June 2027
- Check is for all times tables from 1-12.
- Children have to answer 25 questions.
- We will be using TT Rockstars throughout the year to help build knowledge and speed.

Homework

- Homework includes a weekly maths or English task
- An optional activity from the homework grid can also be completed and is linked to other curriculum subjects per term.
- Reading is expected to be done daily
- Spellings and times tables are expected to be practised regularly

Support from home

- Make sure your child is in school as much as possible and on time each morning
- Support your child with reading, spellings and homework
- Keep us informed of anything that may affect your child's learning or happiness.
- Keep an eye on the class webpage on our school website. This will be updated regularly to let you know what we are learning and what is happening



Notices
