Objectives of spending PPG

Our key objective in using the Pupil Premium Grant was to use the funding to narrow and close the gap between the achievement of these pupils and their peers by providing additional educational support to improve the progress and to raise the standard of achievement for these pupils.

We have used existing research and publications including those from the OfSTED Good Practice series and finding of studies undertaken by the Education Endowment Foundation to enable us to make decisions relating to provision.

We have invested heavily in ensuring that the success of our Phonics, English and Maths programmes are established by ensuring that we have the necessary materials and resources to teach well and our teaching staff receive comprehensive training.

We have also allocated additional time to implement necessary 1:1 interventions.

We currently do not have pupils in Year 6. Our first cohort of Year 6 is currently expected to be in the academic year 2018-2019.
