

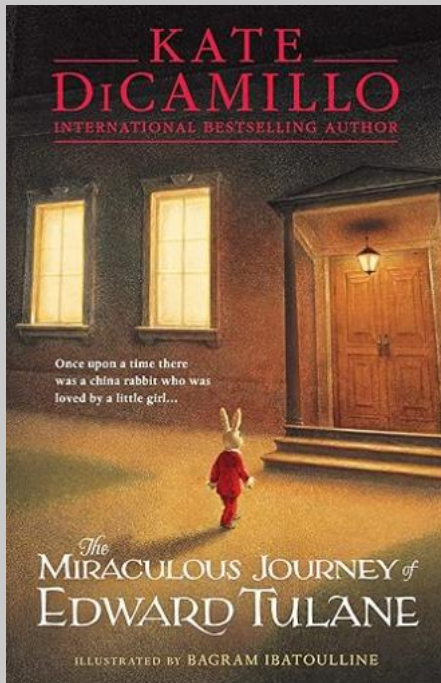
# The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane
