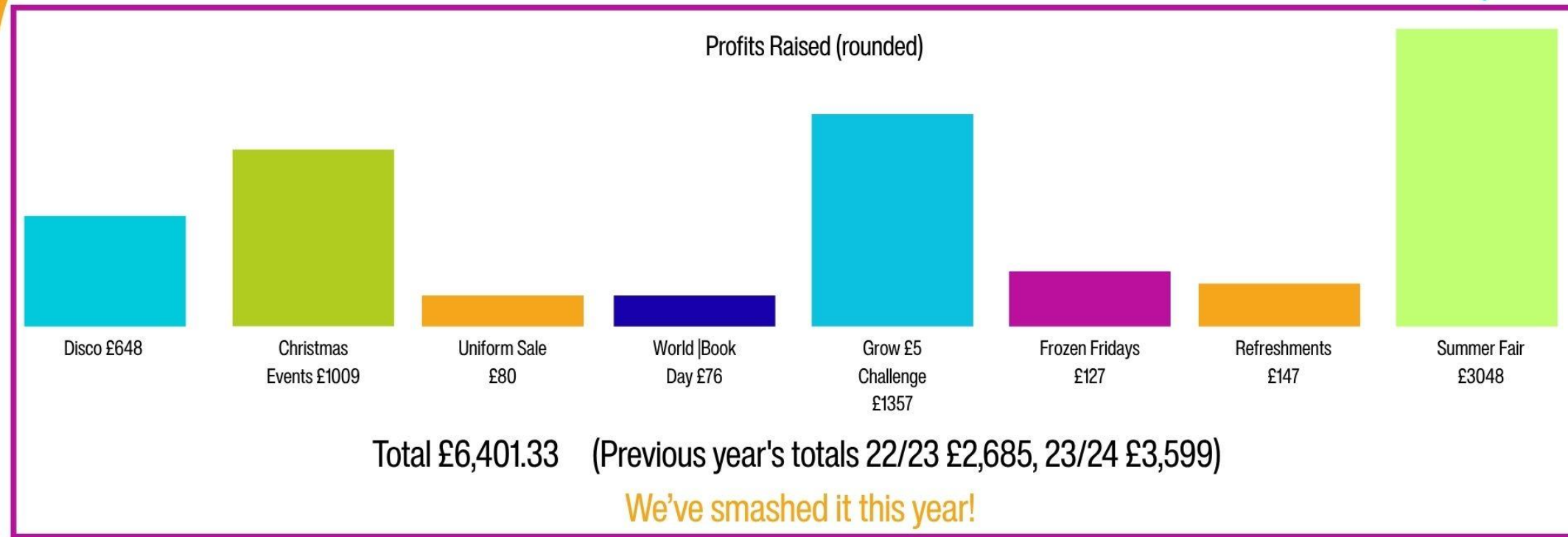

# Getting ready for September

- Label everything!
- Show your child where they can find their name in their uniform
- Familiarise themselves with their uniform, book bag, and PE kit.
- Practise getting themselves dressed in the morning
- Put on and zip up their coat
- Provide Velcro shoes until ready to tie laces
- Practise using a knife and fork
- Practise putting their own belongings in a school bag
- Have a go at asking questions to adults
