ORDINANCE NO. 2026-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF MARSHALLVILLE, WAYNE COUNTY, OHIO
SETTING APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026 AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Marshallville desires to make appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures during the Fiscal year ending December 31, 2026, and *effective January 1, 2026.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Marshallville, Wayne County, Ohio that:

Section 1: That to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Marshallville during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2026 the sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

Section 2: That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payments of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by Village Council authorized by law to approve that same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or

wages except to persons employed by authority of an and in accordance with law or ordinances. Provided further that the appropriations that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expenses constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by specific appropriations herein made.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with the applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.


Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, peace, property, and welfare; and for the further reason to pay bills. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
