ORDINANCE NO. 2026-08

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF MARSHALLVILLE, WAYNE COUNTY, OHIO ACCEPTING THE BID OF BLD SERVICES LLC AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR/FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BLD SERVICES LLC FOR THE VILLAGE'S MANHOLE AND PIPE LINING PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Council for the Village of Marshallville previously authorized advertising of bids for the Village of Marshallville Manhole and Pipe Lining Project, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village obtained an engineer's estimate for the cost of the project as required under Ohio bidding requirements for such projects and the Ohio Revised Code, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has received multiple bids for the project and the Village now desires to authorize the Mayor/Fiscal Officer to enter into an Agreement with BLD Services LLC for the project as they were the lowest and best bid for the project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Marshallville, Wayne County, Ohio that:


**Section 1:** The bid of BLD Services LLC is the lowest and best bid of the bids received for the project.

**Section 2:** The Mayor/Fiscal Officer or their designee is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with BLD Services LLC pursuant to the bid attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked as Exhibit 'A' for the Manhole and Pipelining Project.

**Section 3:** That it is found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with the applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.

**Section 4:** This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, peace, property, and welfare; and for the further reason to comply with the timeline set for by the bidding requirements. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
