ORDINANCE NO. 2025-12

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF MARSHALLVILLE, WAYNE COUNTY OHIO
SUPPLEMENTING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS OF THE VILLAGE AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Council of the Village previously set the appropriations and expenses for 2025, and

WHEREAS, Council has now determined that additional expenses will arise and need to supplement the appropriations to cover those increases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Marshallville, Wayne County, Ohio that:

1. That to provides for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Marshallville during the fiscal year that ends December 31, 2025 the following additional and supplemental amounts are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:
 - a. General Fund – Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$25,000.00)
 - b. Income Tax Fund-Twenty Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$20,000.00)
 - c. Fire Fund-One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$150,000.00)
 - d. Ambulance Fund-Twenty Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$20,000.00)
 - e. Fire Equipment Fund-Thirty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Dollars and 00/100 (\$35,790.00)
 - f. Court Computer Fund-Four Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$4,000.00)
 - g. Water Fund-One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$1,200,000.00)
 - h. Electric Fund-Seventy Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$70,000.00)
 - i. Klusch Fund-Three Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$3,000.00)
2. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with the applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, peace, property, and welfare; and for the further reason to pay bills. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
