ORDINANCE NO. 2025-13

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF MARSHALLVILLE, WAYNE COUNTY OHIO
AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED
RESOURCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code section 5705.36 requires the Fiscal Officer to certify to the Wayne County Auditor the estimated resources of the Village and certify to the Budget Commission any revenue amount later determined to be deficient or in excess of the original amount so certified, and

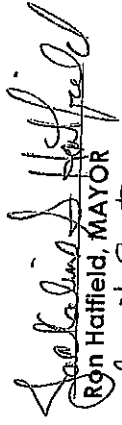
WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer and Council have determined that their revenue amounts in excess of the original amount and need to amend the certification.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Marshallville,
Wayne County, Ohio that:**

1. The Fiscal Officer is directed to report all deficient or excess revenue to the Auditor and the Budget Commission so said revenue may be appropriated by the Village.
2. The following funds have been determined to have increased or excess revenue:
 - a. A1-General Fund-Ten Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$10,000.00)
 - b. B10-Income Tax Fund-Twenty Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$20,000.00)
 - c. B11-Fire Fund- Thirty Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$30,000.00)
 - d. B13-Ambulance Fund-Forty Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$40,000.00)
 - e. E1-Water Fund-One Million Fifty Three Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$1,053,000.00)
3. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with the applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.
4. This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, peace, property, and welfare; and for the further reason to pay bills. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
